24 giugno 2018 – Natività' di S. Giovanni Battista

La fisionomia spirituale del Battista è legata ad alcuni tratti fondamentali. Innanzitutto la sua nascita gloriosa, narrata da Luca in una pagina molto intensa di cui la liturgia odierna ci offre il brano centrale. Egli è per eccellenza dono di Dio, dato che nasce dalla vecchiaia ormai sterile di Elisabetta e dall'incredulità "muta" di Zaccaria. Egli è il profeta definitivo: "Tu, bambino, sarai chiamato profeta dell'Altissimo... Giovanni un profeta? Sì, vi dico, e più che un profeta" (Lc 1, 76; 7, 26). Egli è ricolmo dello Spirito di Dio fin dal grembo materno perché la sua missione sarà totalmente consacrata a Dio e al suo Cristo. Il secondo lineamento del suo ritratto è nella sua voce, tempestosa come quella dei profeti antichi, e nella testimonianza che non conosce esitazioni. Come dirà Gesù, Giovanni non è una canna che si piega al vento, è una quercia che può essere solo spezzata. Ecco, allora, il terzo tratto legato ad un atto preciso, quello del battesimo di Gesù. La voce del Battista e la sua mano puntano diritte su quell'uomo che è nella folla degli ascoltatori: "Ecco l'agnello di Dio che toglie il peccato del mondo!" (Gv 1, 29). E il battesimo che egli compie su Gesù si trasforma in una grandiosa epifania divina. Canterà l'evangelista suo omonimo: "Egli venne come testimone per rendere testimonianza alla luce. Non era lui la luce..." (Gv 1,7-8). L'ultimo tratto del Battista è nella donazione totale, nello stile dei grandi profeti. I Vangeli, infatti, ci riferiscono la passione e la morte di Giovanni in un racconto ampio e carico di venerazione. La sua era stata la storia di un uomo straordinario che aveva avuto la coscienza della grandezza della sua vocazione ma anche del limite della sua missione.

Bellissimo a questo proposito è l'autoritratto che egli abbozza sulla base di un uso giudaico, quello dell'"amico dello sposo", cioè del mediatore ufficiale tra lo sposo e la sposa prima delle nozze: "Non sono io il Cristo. Chi possiede la sposa è lo sposo; ma l'amico dello sposo esulta di gioia alla voce dello sposo... Bisogna che lui cresca e che io diminuisca" (Gv 3,28-30). (G. Ravasi).

O Padre, che hai mandato san Giovanni Battista a preparare a Cristo Signore un popolo ben disposto, allieta la tua Chiesa con l'abbondanza dei doni dello Spirito, e guidala sulla via della salvezza e della pace. Per il nostro Signore...
