3 giugno 2018 – Solennità del SS.mo Corpo e Sangue di Cristo

Quanta gente dice oggi: "Vorrei vedere il volto di Cristo, i suoi lineamenti, le sue vesti, i suoi sandali". Ebbene, è lui che vedi, che tocchi, che mangi! Desideri vedere le sue vesti; ed è lui stesso che si dona a te non solo per esser visto, ma toccato, mangiato, accolto nel cuore. Nessuno dunque si avvicini con indifferenza o con mollezza; ma tutti vengano a lui con l'anima ardente di amore (S. Giovanni Crisostomo).

Colui che si nutre di Cristo nell'Eucaristia non deve attendere l'aldilà per ricevere la vita eterna: la possiede già sulla terra, come primizia della pienezza futura, che riguarderà l'uomo nella sua totalità. Nell'Eucaristia riceviamo infatti anche la garanzia della resurrezione corporea alla fine del mondo: *chi mangia la mia carne e beve il mio sangue ha la vita eterna e io lo risusciterò nell'ultimo giorno* (Gv 6.54). Il Signore ha voluto rimanere con noi nell'Eucaristia, inscrivendo in questa sua presenza sacrificale e conviviale la promessa di un'umanità rinnovata dal suo amore. Significativamente, il Vangelo di Giovanni, laddove i sinottici narrano l'istituzione dell'Eucaristia, propone, illustrandone così il significato profondo, il racconto della lavanda dei piedi, in cui Gesù si fa maestro di comunione e di servizio. Da parte sua, l'apostolo Paolo qualifica indegno di una comunità cristiana il partecipare alla Cerna del Signore, quando ciò avvenga in un contesto di divisione e di indifferenza per i poveri (1Cor 11.17-22.27-34). Annunciare la morte del Signore *finché egli venga* (1Cor 11.26) comporta, per quanti partecipano all'Eucaristia, l'impegno di trasformare la vita, perché essa diventi, in certo modo, tutta eucaristica (Giovanni Paolo II, *Ecclesia de Eucharistia* 18-20).

Nessun sacramento in realtà è più salutare di questo: per sua virtù vengono cancellati i peccati, crescono le buone disposizioni, e la mente viene arricchita di tutti i carismi spirituali. Nella Chiesa l'Eucaristia viene offerta per i vivi e per i morti, perché gioia a tutti, essendo stata istituita per la salvezza di tutti. Nessuno infine può

esprimere la soavità di questo sacramento. Per mezzo di esso si gusta la dolcezza spirituale nella sua stessa fonte e si fa memoria di quella altissima carità, che Cristo ha dimostrato nella sua passione. Egli istituì l'Eucaristia nell'ultima cena, quando, celebrata la Pasqua con i suoi discepoli, stava per passare dal mondo al Padre.

L'Eucaristia è il memoriale della passione, il compimento delle figure dell'Antica Alleanza, la più grande di tutte le meraviglie operate dal Cristo, il mirabile documento del suo amore immenso per gli uomini (S. Tommaso d'Aquino).
