PENTECOST SUNDAY

Dear Brothers and Sisters, The Solemnity of Pentecost which we are celebrating today concludes the liturgical season of Easter. In fact, the paschal mystery — the passion, death and resurrection of Christ and His ascension into Heaven — finds its fulfilment in the powerful outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles gathered together with Mary, Mother of the Lord, and the other disciples. It was the “baptism” of the Church, baptism in the Holy Spirit (cf. Acts 1:5). As the Acts of the Apostles recount, on the morning of the feast of Pentecost, a noise as of wind burst into the Upper Room and tongues of fire, as it were, came to rest upon each of the disciples (cf. Acts 2:2-3). St Gregory the Great commented: “Today, the Holy Spirit has come down upon the disciples with an unexpected sound and changed the minds of carnal beings within His love; and while He appeared externally in tongues of fire, their hearts blazed within them, because in receiving God in the vision of fire, they burned gently with love” (*Hom. in Evang. XXX, 1: CCL 141, 256*). God’s voice divinized the human language of the Apostles who were enabled to proclaim the one divine Word in a “polyphonic” manner. The breath of the Holy Spirit fills the universe, generates faith, leads to truth, and predisposes people to unity. “At this sound the multitude came together, and they were bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in his own language” of “the mighty works of God” (Acts 2:6,11).

Bl. Antonio Rosmini explained that “on the day of Christian Pentecost God promulgated... His law of love, writing it through the Holy Spirit not on stone but in the hearts of the Apostles, and through the Apostles, subsequently communicating it to the entire Church” (*A Catechism of Christian Doctrine Arranged According to the Order of Ideas*, n. 737, Turin, 1863). The Holy Spirit, “who is the Lord and Giver of life” — as we say in the *Creed* — is joined to the Father through the Son and completes the revelation of the Blessed Trinity. He comes from God like a breath from His mouth and has the power of sanctifying, abolishing divisions, dispelling the confusion due to sin. Incorporeal and immaterial, He lavishes divine goods upon living beings and sustains them so that they may act in conformity with the good. As an intelligible Light He gives meaning to prayer, vigour to the evangelizing mission, He makes the hearts of those who listen to the happy message burn and inspires Christian art and liturgical music.

Dear friends, the Holy Spirit who creates faith within us at the moment of our Baptism enables us to live as children of God, aware and consenting, in accordance with the image of the Only-Begotten Son. The power to forgive sins is also a gift of the Holy Spirit; in fact, in appearing to the Apostles on the evening of Easter Day, Jesus breathed upon them and said: “Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven” (Jn 20:22, 23). Let us entrust the Church to the Virgin Mary, temple of the Holy Spirit, so that she may always live by Jesus Christ, by His word, by His commandments and, under the

perennial action of the Spirit Paraclete, proclaim to one and all that “Jesus is Lord!” (1 Cor 12:3).

Pentecoste - 8 giugno 2014

"Quanto all'«economia» stabilita per l'uomo dal nostro magnifico Dio e Salvatore Gesù Cristo, secondo la bontà di Dio, chi dunque rifiuterà [di attribuirne] la piena realizzazione della grazia dello Spirito? Si considerino pure il passato, le benedizioni dei Patriarchi, l'aiuto portato dal dono della Legge, i «tipi», le profezie, le azioni brillanti in guerra, i miracoli compiuti dai giusti, o le disposizioni relative alla venuta del Signore nella carne, tutto fu realizzato dallo Spirito. Egli fu all'inizio presente alla carne del Signore, quando di lui divenne l'«unzione» e l'inseparabile compagno, come è scritto: *"Colui sul quale vedrai discendere e posarsi lo Spirito, è il mio Figlio diletto"* (Jn 1,33 Lc 3,22) e *"Gesù di Nazaret, che Dio consacrò in Spirito Santo"* (Ac 10,38). Poi tutta l'attività di Cristo si compì in presenza dello Spirito. Egli era là anche quando fu tentato dal diavolo, poiché sta scritto: *"Gesù fu condotto dallo Spirito nel deserto per essere tentato"* (Mt 4,1). Ed era ancora con lui, inseparabilmente, quando Gesù compiva i suoi miracoli, perché *"io scaccio i demoni per virtù dello Spirito di Dio..."* (Mt 12,28). Egli non l'ha lasciato dopo la sua Risurrezione dai morti: quando il Signore, per rinnovare l'uomo e per restituirgli - giacché l'aveva perduta - la grazia ricevuta dal soffio di Dio, quando il Signore soffiò sulla faccia dei discepoli, che cosa ha detto? *"Ricevete lo Spirito Santo; a chi rimetterete i peccati saranno rimessi e a chi non li rimetterete, resteranno non rimessi"* (Jn 20,22-23). E l'organizzazione della Chiesa? Non è evidentemente, e senza contraddizione, opera dello Spirito Santo? Infatti, secondo san Paolo, è lui che ha dato alla Chiesa *"in primo luogo degli apostoli, in secondo luogo dei profeti, in terzo luogo dei dottori; poi il dono dei miracoli, poi i carismi di guarigione, di assistenza, di governo, di lingue diverse"* (1Co 12,28). Lo Spirito distribuisce quest'ordine secondo la ripartizione dei suoi doni (S. Basilio di Cesarea, *De Spir. Sancto*, 16, 39)."

"Ma ora, è solo una parte del suo Spirito che noi riceviamo, per disporci in anticipo e prepararci all'incorruttibilità, abituandoci a poco a poco a comprendere e a portare Dio. È ciò che l'Apostolo chiama «caparra» - cioè una parte soltanto di quell'onore che ci è stato promesso da Dio -, allorché nella lettera agli Efesini dice: *"È in lui che anche voi, dopo aver ascoltato la parola di verità, il vangelo della vostra salvezza, è in lui che, dopo aver creduto, voi siete stati segnati con il sigillo dello Spirito Santo della promessa, che è la caparra della vostra eredità"* (Ep 1,13-14). Se dunque questa caparra, dimorando in noi ci rende già spirituali e se ciò che è mortale è assorbito dall'immortalità (2Co 5,4) - infatti *"quanto a voi"*, dice egli, *"non siete nella carne, ma nello Spirito, se è vero che lo Spirito di Dio abita in voi"* (Rm 8,9) -, e se, d'altra parte, ciò si realizza non con il rifiuto della carne, bensì per la comunione dello Spirito - in effetti coloro a cui egli scriveva non erano degli esseri disincarnati, ma persone che avevano ricevuto lo Spirito di Dio *"nel quale gridiamo: Abbà, Padre"* (Rm 8,15) -; se dunque, fin da ora, per aver ricevuto questa caparra, noi gridiamo

"*Abbà, Padre*", che sarà quando, risuscitati, "*lo vedremo a faccia a faccia*" ([1Co 13,12](#))? Quando tutte le membra, a fiotti straripanti, faranno sgorgare un inno di esultanza, glorificando colui che li ha risuscitati dai morti e li ha gratificati della vita eterna? Infatti, se già una semplice caparra, avvolgendo in se stessa l'uomo da ogni parte, lo fa gridare: "*Abbà, Padre*", cosa non farà la grazia intera dello Spirito, una volta data agli uomini da Dio? Essa ci renderà simili a lui e compirà la volontà del Padre, poiché farà l'uomo ad immagine e somiglianza di Dio ([Gn 1,26](#)) (**S. Ireneo di Lione, *Adv. Haer. V, 8, 1*.**)"
