Regular Sunday Mass schedule. Divine Mercy Celebration begins at 2:30 p.m. Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament, Sung Divine Mercy Chaplet and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Bring religious items to be blessed.

**REMINDER: All Fridays of the year are days of abstinence from meat** but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. Christian fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open to prayer, to the needs of others, and to save money to give to the poor. Current Church discipline permits one to take a main and two lesser meals which do not equal the main meal. **Mandatory fast days are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, on which days one must abstain from meat and eat only one main meal. Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence and meat may not be taken on these days. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age.** Parents are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance. Adult example will be the greatest influence in this matter.
