GUIDELINES FOR LENTEN FASTING & ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. All Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. In Canada, Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. Fasting is obligatory from ages 18-59. However, the law of abstinence binds those who are ages 14 and above. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat only one full meal, and two small snacks that together don't add up to a full meal.

"Gesù è chiaro: non guardare alla pagliuzza nell'occhio del fratello tu che hai un trave nell'occhio. Quant'è vero! Quanta fatica faccio a riconoscere i miei sbagli! Quanto sono pronto a giustificarli, ad attenuarli! Con me sono comprensivo e benevolo, con gli errori degli altri sono spietato e giudico con durezza eccessiva. Esagero? Ascoltatevi! Ascoltiamoci quando si tratta di parlare di un'altra persona, dei miei vicini, dell'amministratore del mio condominio. Siamo sempre troppo adolescenti, intenti a proteggerci per paura che qualcuno ci ferisca, sempre troppo concentrati a far apparire il meglio di noi per paura che gli altri non vedano il peggio. Liberi, amici, liberi! Siamo aquile fatte per volare, sbattete le ali! Dio ci dona ali di aquila per accogliere ciò che siamo con verità, per imparare ad amarci e ad amare gli altri con semplicità, per sapere che siamo capolavori in costruzione e durante i lavori in corso uno sopporta un po' di polvere e di rumore.
