THE HOLY SEASON OF LENT

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5th. We should give some consideration to our Lenten penance and practices as we prepare to celebrate the Paschal Triduum. On the first day of Lent, ashes are blessed and used to mark the heads of the faithful as a sign of penance. In the fourth century, public penitents wearing sackcloth were sprinkled with ashes as a sign of penitence. As public penance was gradually discontinued, it became customary for all the faithful to receive ashes in beginning Lenten penance as preparation for Easter.

On Ash Wednesday, March 5th. **Holy Mass and distribution of ashes at 8:00 a.m. (English); 12:00 p.m. (Italian); 7:00 p.m. (English).** Lent is the yearly celebration by the Church of her corporate conversion in Jesus Christ. Through forty days of closer attention to God's Word and of more fervent prayer, we prepare to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. In this preparation for the Solemn Feast of Easter, the faithful do penance.

The privileged forms of penance of our Church are fasting, almsgiving, prayers, works of mercy, and abstinence from meat. It is evangelical (Gospel) law that a follower of Christ must do penance. While the heart of penance is hatred for sin as an offence against God, external forms of penance are required to deepen and encourage the internal virtue.

All Fridays of the year are days of abstinence from meat but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. Christian fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open to prayer, to the needs of others, and to save money to give to the poor. Current Church discipline permits one to take a main and two lesser meals which do not equal the main meal. **Mandatory fast days are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, on which days one must abstain from meat and eat only one main meal. Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence and meat may not be taken on these days. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age.** Parents are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance. Adult example will be the greatest influence in this matter.

DEVOTION TO THE HOLY FACE OF JESUS

This ancient and venerable Catholic practice is rooted in the representation of the face of Christ said to have been left on the towel or veil used by a holy woman thought to be named, Veronica. An Archconfraternity of the Holy Face was established in Tours, France, 1884; its members make reparation for the blasphemies hurled at Christ. Since St. Therese's devotion to the Holy Face has become known, this devotion has spread worldwide.

In addition, a devout and pious nun, Sr. Pierina, who died in 1945, was given many visions through Our Blessed Lady who appeared to her, as did Our Lord Jesus. They urged her to make reparation for the many insults Jesus suffered in His Passion, such as to be slapped, spit upon and kissed by Judas, as well as now being dishonored in many ways in the Blessed Sacrament by neglect, sacrileges, and profanations.

She was given a medal which on one side bore a replica of the Holy Shroud and the inscription: "Illumina, Domine, vultum tuum super nos." [O Lord, the light of Thy countenance shine upon us.] On the reverse side was a radiant host with the words: "Mane nobiscum, Domine." [Stay with us, O Lord.] Pope St. Pius XII obeyed and had this day set aside to honor the Holy Face in 1958. *(Taken from www.catholictradition.org)*

The tears which well up abundantly in Thy sacred eyes appear to me as so many precious pearls that I love to gather up, in order to purchase the souls of poor sinners by means of their infinite value. O Jesus, whose adorable Face ravishes my heart, I implore Thee to fix deep within me Thy divine image and to set me on fire with Thy Love, that I may be found worthy to come to the contemplation of Thy glorious Face in Heaven. Amen.

"Disprezza le ricchezze, se vuoi possedere le ricchezze; sii povero, se vuoi essere ricco. Tali sono infatti gli inattesi beni di Dio, egli vuole che non per tuo studio, bensì per sua grazia, tu diventi ricco. Lascia a me - egli dice - codeste cose: tu cura le cose dello spirito, per apprendere la mia potenza: fuggi dal giogo e dalla schiavitù delle ricchezze. Fintanto che le tratterai in tal modo, sarai povero: allorché invece le disprezzerai, sarai doppiamente ricco; e perché ti perverranno da ogni dove, e perché nulla ti mancherà di quanto invece sono carenti i più. Non è infatti il possedere a dismisura che fa ricco, bensì il non mancare di troppe cose. Perciò, quando c'è l'indigenza, il re in nulla differisce dal povero: la povertà infatti è questo aver bisogno degli altri: proprio per questa ragione il re sia povero, poiché necessita del servizio dei sudditi. Non così per chi è stato crocifisso: di nessuno ha bisogno; al vinto sono sufficienti le proprie mani: *"Alle mie necessità, infatti" - egli dice -, "ed a quelle di coloro che sono con me, hanno provveduto queste mie mani"* (*Ac 20,34*). Queste cose dice chi, altrove, afferma: *"Quasi come chi non ha nulla, e tutto possiede"* (*2Co 6,10*); proprio lui che a Listra ritenevano che fosse un dio. Se vuoi conseguire le cose del mondo, cerca il cielo se vuoi fruire delle cose presenti, disprezzale: senza equivoci, infatti, dice [Gesù]: *"Cercate prima di tutto il regno di Dio, e tutto il resto vi sarà dato in aggiunta"* (*Mt 6,33*). S. Giovanni Crisostomo, *In Epist. I ad Timoth. 3*).

"Se dopo tutti questi argomenti e tutti questi esempi, non siete ancora capaci di sciogliere le dure catene che vi legano, liberatevi dall'affanno almeno riconoscendone l'inutilità. "Chi di voi", infatti, "con l'affannarsi può aggiungere alla sua età una spanna"? (*Mt 6,27*) - aggiunge Cristo. Vedete come egli si serve ora di un paragone chiaro e comprensibile, per far capire una verità oscura e nascosta. Pur dandovi da fare - egli dice - voi non potete far crescere neppure un poco il vostro corpo; ebbene, allo stesso modo non potete neppure con tutte le preoccupazioni e gli affanni assicurarvi il cibo. Con queste parole Gesù ci fa vedere con estrema chiarezza che non è affatto la nostra cura, ma soltanto la provvidenza di Dio che compie tutto, anche in quelle cose in cui sembra che noi abbiamo parte attiva. Se Dio infatti ci abbandonasse, nessuna cosa più sussisterebbe e periremmo tutti inevitabilmente con i nostri affanni, le nostre inquietudini e le nostre fatiche (S. Giovanni Crisostomo, *In Matth. 21, 3*)."

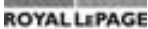
