### 5a di Quaresima – 22 marzo 2015

"Qual sacrificio fu mai più sacro di quello che il vero Pontefice posa sull'altare della croce immolando su di lei

la propria carne? Benché, inverò, la morte di molti santi sia stata preziosa agli occhi del Signore (*Ps 115,15*), mai tuttavia l'uccisione di un innocente ebbe come causa la propiziazione del mondo. I giusti hanno ricevuto la propria corona di gloria, non ne hanno donate, la forza d'animo dei fedeli ha prodotto esempi di pazienza, non doni di giustizia. La loro morte rimase propria a ciascuno di loro e nessuno con il proprio transito acquistò il debito di un altro; nostro Signore, invece, unico tra i figli degli uomini, è stato il solo in cui tutti sono stati crocifissi, tutti sono morti, tutti sono stati sepolti, tutti del pari sono risuscitati; ed è di loro che egli stesso diceva: "*Quando sarò levato in alto attirerò tutto a me*" (*Jn 12,32*). In effetti, la vera fede che giustifica gli empi (*Rm 4,5*) e crea i giusti (*Ep 2,10 Ep 4,24*), attratta a colui che condivide la sua natura, acquista in lui la salvezza, in lui nel quale essa si è ritrovata innocente; e poiché "*non vi è che un unico mediatore tra Dio e gli uomini, l'uomo Cristo Gesù*" (*1Tm 2,5*) è per la comunione con la sua stirpe che l'uomo ha ritrovato la pace con Dio; può così, in tutta libertà, gloriarsi (*1Co 3,21 Ph 3,3 2Co 10,17*) della potenza di colui che, nella infermità della nostra carne, ha affrontato un nemico superbo e ha fatto dono della sua vittoria a coloro nel cui corpo egli ha trionfato (S. Leone Magno, Sermo, 51, 3)."

"Non soltanto, quindi, non dobbiamo arrossire della morte del Signore, nostro Dio, ma ci dobbiamo grandemente confidare in essa e aver motivo di somma gloria: accettando infatti, la morte da noi, che egli trovò in noi, sposò nel modo più fedele la vita che ci avrebbe dato, che noi non possiamo avere da noi. In effetti, colui che ci amò tanto, che ciò che meritammo col peccato, egli, senza peccato, patì per noi peccatori, come colui che giustifica non ci darà ciò con giustizia? Come non ci restituirà, i premi dei santi, colui che promette con verità, colui che, innocente, sopportò la pena dei colpevoli? Confessiamo, dunque, fratelli, coraggiosamente, ed anche professiamo: Cristo è stato crocifisso per noi: non vi spaventate ma siate nella gioia; proclamiamolo non con vergogna ma con gioia. Osservò così il Cristo l'apostolo Paolo e raccomandò tale titolo di gloria. Ed egli, avendo molti titoli, grandi e divini, che egli ricordasse del Cristo, non disse di gloriarsi delle meraviglie del Cristo, poiché, essendo anche uomo, come siamo noi, ebbe il dominio nel mondo; ma disse: *Per me di non altro voglio gloriarmi, che della croce del Nostro Signore Gesù Cristo* (*Ga 6,14*) (S. Agostino)."

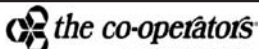
