THE LAMB OF GOD WHO TAKES AWAY THE SINS OF THE WORLD

After agreeing to baptize Him along with the sinners, John the Baptist looked at Jesus and pointed Him out as the "Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world". By doing so, he reveals that Jesus is at the same time the suffering Servant who silently allows Himself to be led to the slaughter and who bears the sin of the multitudes, and also the Paschal Lamb, the symbol of Israel's redemption at the first Passover. Christ's whole life expresses His mission: "to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many." *Catechism of the Catholic Church, #608.*

THE SACRED LITURGY DURING HOLY WEEK

During Holy week, the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ Our Lord in the last days of His life on earth, beginning with His messianic entrance into Jerusalem. The Lenten season lasts until the Thursday of this week. The Easter Triduum begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper and is continued through Good Friday with the celebration of the Passion of our Lord and Holy Saturday, to reach its summit in the Easter Vigil, and concludes with Vespers of Easter Sunday.

PALM SUNDAY Holy week begins today on Passion Sunday (Palm Sunday), which joins the foretelling of Christ's regal triumph & proclamation of the Passion.

HOLY THURSDAY - EVENING MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

With the celebration of Mass on the evening of Holy Thursday, the Church begins the Easter Triduum and recalls the Last Supper in which the Lord Jesus, on the night He was betrayed, showing His love for those who were His own in the world, gave His Body and Blood under the species of bread and wine offering to His Father and giving them to the Apostles so that they might partake of Them, and He commanded them and their successors in the priesthood to perpetuate this offering. In this Mass, three mysteries are commemorated: **the Institution of the Eucharist, the Institution of the Priesthood, and Christ's command of brotherly love.** After the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the faithful are encouraged to spend a suitable period of time in the Church in adoration before the Blessed Sacrament that has been solemnly reserved. Please note that the Church will be open only until midnight.

GOOD FRIDAY On this day, when Christ our Passover was sacrificed, the Church meditates on the Passion of her Lord and Spouse; adores the Cross, commemorates her origin from the side of Christ on the Cross; and intercedes for the salvation of the whole world. On this day, in accordance with ancient tradition, the Church does not celebrate the Eucharist: Holy Communion is distributed to the Faithful during the celebration of the Lord's Passion. **Good Friday is a day of penance to be observed as an obligation in the whole Church.**

HOLY SATURDAY The Church is, as it were, at the Lord's tomb meditating on His Passion and Death and on His descent into the dead awaiting His Resurrection **with prayer and fasting.**

THE PASCHAL FAST The Faithful are reminded that the Paschal fast is to be observed on Good Friday. If possible, it should be continued on Holy Saturday. This means abstinence from meat and only one full meal on these days. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18-59 years of age. By this observance, we shall be prepared to receive the joys of the Lord's Resurrection with uplifted and responsive hearts.

GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION will take place in all the churches of the world in support of the Holy Places in the Holy Land. The mission of the "Commissariat of the Holy Land" is to help the Christian communities of the Holy Land and is made possible with the generosity of all the Catholics in Canada. Each year your support sustains apostolic and social works and the upkeep of the Holy Sites we as Catholics hold so dear. In the words of His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI " *The Church of the Holy Land, which so often experienced the dark mystery of Golgotha, must never cease to be an intrepid herald of the luminous message of hope which this empty tomb proclaims. For us too, we can bring this message of hope and light to others! We can also be pilgrims of peace! Please support those that live this challenge on our behalf.*" **Thank you for your contribution.**

Gloria a te che vieni, pieno di bontà e di misericordia(Antifona d'ingresso).

La prova unica e suprema della carità è data dall'amore portato al nemico. Per questo la stessa Verità affronta il patibolo della croce e tuttavia attua la carità verso gli stessi persecutori, pregando: *Padre, perdona loro, perché non sanno quello che compiono* (Lc 23.34). Che meraviglia quindi se i discepoli, in vita, amano i nemici, dal momento che il maestro, subendo la morte, li ha pure amati? La prova suprema della carità e da lui descritta così: *Nessuno ha un amore più grande di chi dà la vita per i suoi amici* (Gv 15.13). Il Signore era venuto a morire anche per i nemici, e tuttavia affermava che avrebbe dato la vita per gli amici, certo per insegnarci che, siccome possiamo acquistarci dei meriti amando i nemici, possono, in un certo senso, essere considerati amici anche quelli che ci perseguitano (Gregorio Magno, *Omelie* 27.2).

Piangono coloro che Gesù guarda. Pietro ha negato una prima volta, e non ha pianto, perché il Signore non lo aveva guardato. Ha negato una seconda volta, e di nuovo non ha pianto, perché ancora il Signore non aveva rivolto il suo sguardo verso di lui. Nega una terza volta: Gesù lo guarda, *ed egli pianse amaramente* (Lc 22, 61-62). Guardaci, Signore Gesù, affinché noi sappiamo piangere i nostri peccati (Ambrogio, *Comm. a Luca* 10.89).

Cristo condusse in Paradiso il ladrone nonostante il peso delle sue colpe. È straordinario e incredibile! Vedi la croce e ti viene in mente il Regno? Che cosa hai visto mai che possa esserne degno? Un uomo crocifisso, schiaffeggiato, deriso, accusato, coperto di sputi, flagellato: tutto questo forse è degno del Regno? Vedi allora come il ladrone guardò con gli occhi della fede, senza lasciarsi ingannare dalle apparenze.
