GUIDELINES FOR LENTEN FASTING & ABSTINENCE

All Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. In Canada, Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. Fasting is obligatory from ages 18-59. However, the law of abstinence binds those who are ages 14 and above.

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat only one full meal, and two small snacks that together don't add up to a full meal.

Cardinal Collins and bishops across Ontario are asking for an email address from every Catholic family in their community, with a goal of 100,000 email addresses collected by the end of February 2018.
