ASCENSION OF OUR LORD

No one has ever ascended into heaven except the one who descended from heaven

Today our Lord Jesus Christ ascended into heaven; let our hearts ascend with Him. Listen to the words of the Apostle: *If you have risen with Christ, set your hearts on the things that are above where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God; seek the things that are above, not the things that are on earth.* For just as He remained with us even after His ascension, so we too are already in heaven with Him, even though what is promised us has not yet been fulfilled in our bodies.

Christ is now exalted above the heavens, but He still suffers on earth all the pain that we, the members of His body, have to bear. He showed this when He cried out from above: *Saul, Saul, why do you persecute Me?* and when He said: *I was hungry and you gave Me food.*

Why do we on earth not strive to find rest with Him in heaven even now, through the faith, hope and love that unites us to Him? While in heaven He is also with us; and we while on earth are with Him. He is here with us by His divinity, His power and His love. We cannot be in heaven, as He is on earth, by divinity, but in Him, we can be there by love.

He did not leave heaven when He came down to us; nor did He withdraw from us when He went up again into heaven. The fact that He was in heaven even while He was on earth is borne out by His own statement: *No one has ever ascended into heaven except the one who descended from heaven, the Son of Man, who is in heaven.*

These words are explained by our oneness with Christ, for He is our head and we are His body. No one ascended into heaven except Christ because we also are Christ: He is the Son of Man by His union with us, and we by our union with Him are the sons of God. So the Apostle says: *Just as the human body, which has many members, is a unity, because all the different members make one body, so is it also with Christ.* He too has many members, but one body.

Out of compassion for us He descended from heaven, and although He ascended alone, we also ascend, because we are in Him by grace. Thus, no one but Christ descended and no one but Christ ascended; not because there is no distinction between the head and the body, but because the body as a unity cannot be separated from the head.

God the Father wishes Mary to be the mother of His children until the end of time and so He says to her, "Dwell in Jacob", that is to say, take up your abode permanently in my children, in My holy ones represented by Jacob, and not in the children of the devil and sinners represented by Esau.

Just as in natural and bodily generation there is a father and a mother, so in the supernatural and spiritual generation there is a father who is God and a mother who is Mary. All true children of God have God for their father and Mary for their mother; anyone who does not have Mary for his mother, does not have God for his father. **This is why the reprobate, such as heretics and schismatics, who hate, despise or ignore the Blessed Virgin, do not have God for their father though they arrogantly claim they have, because they do not have Mary for their mother.** Indeed if they had her for their mother they would love and honor her as good and true children naturally love and honor the mother who gave them life.

An infallible and unmistakable sign by which we can distinguish a heretic, a man of false doctrine, an enemy of God, from one of God's true friends is that the heretic and the hardened sinner show nothing but contempt and indifference for Our Lady. He endeavors by word and example, openly or insidiously - sometimes under specious pretexts - to belittle the love and veneration shown to her. God the Father has not told Mary to dwell in them because they are, alas, other Esaus.

Ascensione del Signore - 12 maggio 2013
"Avrete forza dallo Spirito Santo che scenderà su di voi e mi sarete testimoni (At. 1:8)"

Quaranta giorni dopo la Pasqua, la Chiesa celebra l'Ascensione del Signore, il coronamento della Sua Resurrezione, quando Egli ritorna "al mio Padre ad al vostro Padre" (Gv. 20:17). L'Ascensione é anche preludio alla prossima festa della Pentecoste. Perciò, nel vangelo di oggi, udiamo le ultime parole di Gesù, che ci dicono della grande promessa dello Spirito Santo: "E io manderò su di voi quello che il Padre mio ha promesso; ma voi restate in città, finché non siate rivestiti di potenza dall'alto." (Lk. 24:49). Nella sua Lettera Apostolica, Novo Millennio Ineunte, Papa Giovanni Paolo II ci ha lasciato un chiaro "programma per il terzo millennio" (NMI, 29): ci ha detto che "dobbiamo 'prendere il largo' con fiducia nelle parole del Cristo: Duc in altum!" (NMI, 15); ci ha detto che il nucleo essenziale della grande eredità lasciataci dal Grande Giubileo del 2000 é stata "la contemplazione del volto di Cristo" (NMI, 15). Abbiamo cercato di applicare questo programma al nostro Giubileo, come programma che "si incentra, in ultima analisi, in Cristo stesso, da conoscere, amare, imitare, per vivere in lui la vita trinitaria, e trasformare con lui la storia fino al suo compimento nella Gerusalemme celeste" (NMI, 29). Inoltre, Giovanni Paolo II ha predetto che "il duc in altum della Chiesa del terzo millennio sarà determinato dalla capacità dei cristiani di entrare nella 'perfetta conoscenza di Cristo, mistero di Dio, in cui é nascosto ogni tesoro di sapienza e conoscenza" (Col. 2:2-3)" (RVM, 24).

Ma per entrare in questa "perfetta conoscenza" di Cristo, bisogna essere "rivestiti di potenza dall'alto." Non vi é altro modo di seguire il programma che ci é proposto che nel ricevere il dono dello Spirito Santo, Signore e vivificatore. In questi giorni di preparazione, come gli Apostoli prima della Pentecoste, invociamo l'aiuto di Maria Immacolata, che ci aiuti a convertire le nostre menti ed i nostri cuori in preghiera allo Spirito Santo. In questo modo vivremo più profondamente la promessa di Gesù alla conclusione della Sua missione terrestre: **"Avrete forza dallo Spirito Santo che scenderà su di voi e mi sarete testimoni" (Atti 1:8).**

"Cari figli, siate ripieni di quella speranza che fa parte del mistero dell'Ascensione di Gesù. Siate profondamente convinti della vittoria e del trionfo di Cristo sul peccato e sulla morte. Credete che la forza di Cristo è più grande della nostra debolezza, più grande della debolezza di tutto il mondo. Provate a capire e a condividere la gioia che Maria ha sperimentato nel sapere che suo Figlio aveva preso posto accanto al Padre, che egli infinitamente amava. Rinnovate oggi la vostra fede nella promessa del Signore nostro Gesù Cristo, che è andato a preparare un posto per noi e che di là egli verrà di nuovo per prenderci con sé. (Giovanni Paolo II)."
