**PENTECOST**

On the day of Pentecost when the seven weeks of Easter had come to an end, Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, manifested, given, and communicated as a divine person: of His fullness, Christ, the Lord, pours out the Spirit in abundance.

On that day, the Holy Trinity is fully revealed. Since that day, the Kingdom announced by Christ has been open to those who believe in Him: in the humility of the flesh and in faith, they already share in the communion of the Holy Trinity. By His coming, which never ceases, the Holy Spirit causes the world to enter into the "last days," the time of the Church, the Kingdom already inherited though not yet consummated.

We have seen the true Light, we have received the heavenly Spirit, we have found the true faith: we adore the indivisible Trinity, who has saved us.

"God is Love" and love is His first gift, containing all others. "God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us."

Because we are dead or at least wounded through sin, the first effect of the gift of love is the forgiveness of our sins. The communion of the Holy Spirit in the Church restores to the baptized the divine likeness lost through sin. He, then, gives us the "pledge" or "first fruits" of our inheritance: the very life of the Holy Trinity, which is to love as "God [has] loved us." This love (the "charity" of *1 Cor 13*) is the source of the new life in Christ, made possible because we have received "power" from the Holy Spirit.

By this power of the Spirit, God's children can bear much fruit. He who has grafted us onto the true vine will make us bear "the fruit of the Spirit:... love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

gentleness, self-control." "We live by the Spirit"; the more we renounce ourselves, the more we "walk by the Spirit."

The mission of Christ and the Holy Spirit is brought to completion in the Church, which is the Body of Christ and the Temple of the Holy Spirit. This joint mission henceforth brings Christ's faithful to share in His communion with the Father in the Holy Spirit. The Spirit *prepares* men and goes out to them with His grace, in order to draw them to Christ. The Spirit *manifests* the risen Lord to them, recalls His word to them and opens their minds to the understanding of His Death and Resurrection. He *makes present* the mystery of Christ, supremely in the Eucharist, in order to reconcile them, to *bring them into communion* with God, that they may "bear much fruit."

Thus the Church's mission is not an addition to that of Christ and the Holy Spirit, but is its sacrament: in her whole being and in all her members, the Church is sent to announce, bear witness, make present, and spread the mystery of the communion of the Holy Trinity.

Because the Holy Spirit is the anointing of Christ, it is Christ who, as the head of the Body, pours out the Spirit among His members to nourish, heal, and organize them in their mutual functions, to give them life, send them to bear witness, and associate them to His self-offering to the Father and to His intercession for the whole world. Through the Church's sacraments, Christ communicates His Holy and sanctifying Spirit to the members of His Body.

These "mighty works of God," offered to believers in the sacraments of the Church, bear their fruit in the new life in Christ, according to the Spirit.

"The Spirit helps us in our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit Himself intercedes with sighs too deep for words."

*Catechism of the Catholic Church #731-741.*

**Solemnità della Pentecoste - 23 maggio 2010**

**"Vieni, Santo Spirito, riempi i cuori dei tuoi fedeli e accendi in essi il fuoco del tuo amore." (Acclamazione al Vangelo)**

Qual'è il ruolo specifico dello Spirito Santo nella nostra vita cristiana? Nel contemplare il volto di Cristo, noi sappiamo che tutti i nostri piani e tutto il nostro agire non potranno "non ispirarsi al « comandamento nuovo » che egli ci ha dato: «Come io vi ho amato, così amatevi anche voi gli uni gli altri» (Gv 13,34). (NMI, 42)." Due volte, nel Vangelo di oggi, ascoltiamo le parole di Gesù: "se mi amate, osserverete i miei comandamenti" (Gv. 14:15, 23). Ma come possiamo amare Gesù come egli ama noi; come possiamo amarci gli uni gli altri? È chiaro che questa "comunione" che ci è stato comandato di osservare può essere solo "il frutto e la manifestazione di quell'amore che, sgorgando dal cuore dell'eterno Padre, si riversa in noi attraverso lo Spirito che Gesù ci dona (cfr Rm 5,5), per fare di tutti noi « un cuore solo e un'anima sola » (At 4,32)." (NMI, 42).

Il dono dello Spirito contiene luce per le nostre menti, dato che Egli è "lo Spirito di verità" (Gv. 14:17; 15:26), e fervore per la nostra volontà perché Egli è anche Spirito d'amore, "amore-dono increato" (DV, 10). È per questo che S. Giovanni della Croce ed altri santi hanno parlato della doppia dimensione della contemplazione: contemplazione che imparte comprensione alla mente e fortifica la nostra fede, e contemplazione che infiamma la volontà all'amore e fa bruciare i nostri cuori. Queste due dimensioni devono coesistere in equilibrio se vogliamo "prendere il largo," se vogliamo fare progresso nella vita dello spirito. Tutto questo avviene perché "il Consolatore, lo Spirito Santo che il Padre manderà nel mio nome, egli v'insegnerà ogni cosa e vi ricorderà tutto ciò che io vi ho detto." (Gv. 14:26). Ma non dimentichiamo che "'Dio è amore; chi sta nell'amore dimora in Dio e Dio dimora in lui" (1 Gv 4, 16). Queste parole della Prima Lettera di Giovanni esprimono con singolare chiarezza il centro della fede cristiana" (1 Gv. 4:16)" (DCE, 1). Inoltre, "è lo stesso apostolo Paolo a ricordarcelo nell'inno alla carità: se anche parlassimo le lingue degli uomini e degli angeli, e avessimo una fede « da trasportare le montagne », ma poi mancassimo della carità, tutto sarebbe « nulla » (cf. 1 Cor 13:2)" (NMI, 42). E S. Teresa di Lisieux, che Giovanni Paolo II ha "voluto proclamare Dottore della Chiesa proprio come esperta della scienza amoris: «Capii che la Chiesa aveva un Cuore e che questo Cuore era acceso d'Amore. Capii che solo l'Amore faceva agire le membra della Chiesa [...] Capii che l'Amore racchiudeva tutte le Vocazioni, che l'Amore era tutto»" (NMI, 42).

Quanto è importante il ruolo dello Spirito Santo? Detto semplicemente, "chi non ha lo Spirito di Cristo non appartiene a Cristo" (Rom. 8:9). Perciò, oggi ed ogni altro giorno, uniti a Maria Immacolata, imploriamo e diamo grazie per il dono dello Spirito Santo, luce di Verità, potenza dell'Amore Divino, e preghiamo: "**Vieni, Santo Spirito, riempi i cuori dei tuoi fedeli e accendi in essi il fuoco del tuo amore.**"
