SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters, The book of the Acts of the Apostles states that after a first violent persecution, the Christian community of Jerusalem, except for the Apostles, spread to the surrounding areas. Philip, one of the deacons, arrived in a city of Samaria. There he preached the Risen Christ, and his proclamation was supported by numerous healings, so that the outcome of the episode was very positive: "there was much joy in that city" (Acts 8:8). We are repeatedly impressed in a profound way by this expression, which in essence communicates a sense of hope, as if saying: It is possible! It is possible for humanity to know true joy, because wherever the Gospel comes, life flourishes, just as arid ground, irrigated by rain, immediately turns back to green.

With the strength of the Holy Spirit, Philip and the other disciples accomplished in the villages of Palestine what Jesus had done: They preached the Good News and worked miraculous signs. It was the Lord who acted through them. As Jesus proclaimed the coming of the Kingdom of God, so the disciples proclaimed the Risen Jesus, professing that He is the Christ, the Son of God, baptizing in His name and driving out every illness of body and spirit.

"There was much joy in that city". Reading this passage, one thinks spontaneously of the healing power of the Gospel, which throughout the centuries has "watered" so many populations, like a beneficent river. Several great men and women saints brought hope and peace to entire cities — we think of Charles Borromeo in Milan at the time of the plague, of Bl. Mother Teresa of Calcutta, and of so many missionaries, whose names are known by God, who have given their lives to bring the proclamation of Christ and make profound joy flower among men. While the powers of this world sought to conquer new territories for political and economic interests, Christ's messengers went everywhere with the aim of bringing Christ to men and men to Christ, knowing that He alone can give true freedom and eternal life. Today too the Church's vocation is evangelization: whether it be to populations which have not yet been "irrigated" by the living water of the Gospel, or to those that, though having ancient Christian roots, are in need of new nourishment to bear new fruit and rediscover the beauty and joy of the faith.

Dear friends, St. John Paul II was a great missionary, as an exhibition open now in Rome also documents. He re-launched the mission *ad gentes* and, at the same time, promoted the new evangelization. Let us entrust both to the intercession of Mary Most Holy. May Christ's Mother accompany the proclamation of the Gospel always and everywhere, so that the places where men rediscover the joy of living as children of God will multiply and spread in the world.

6a di Pasqua – 25 maggio 2014

"Vivo e attivo è lui, e appena è entrato ha destato l'anima mia assopita; ha commosso, reso molle e ferito il mio cuore, poiché era duro e di sasso, e insensato. Ha cominciato anche a strappare e a distruggere, a edificare e a piantare, a irrigare ciò che era arido, a illuminare ciò che era tenebroso, a spalancare ciò che era chiuso, a riscaldare ciò che era freddo, e così pure a raddrizzare ciò che era storto, e a cambiare le asperità in vie piane, affinché l'anima mia, e tutto ciò che è in me, benedicesse il Signore e il suo santo nome. Entrando così più volte in me il Verbo, mio sposo, non ha fatto mai conoscere la sua venuta da nessun indizio: non dalla voce, non dall'aspetto, non dal passaggio. Nessun gesto suo insomma lo ha fatto scoprire, nessuno dei miei sensi si è accorto che penetrava nel mio intimo soltanto dal moto del cuore, come ho detto prima ho sentito la sua presenza; dalla fuga dei vizi, dalla stretta dei desideri carnali, ho avvertito la potenza della sua virtù; dallo scuotimento e dalla riprensione delle mie colpe nascoste, ho ammirato la

profondità della sua sapienza; dalla sia pur piccola correzione delle mie abitudini, ho sperimentato la bontà della sua mitezza, dalla trasformazione e dal rinnovamento dello spirito della mia mente, cioè del mio uomo interiore, mi son fatto comunque l'idea della sua bellezza; e nel contempo dall'esame di tutte queste cose, ho avuto timore delle sue grandezze senza numero (*Bernardo di Chiarav., In Cant. Cant. Sermo 74, 6.*)"

"Quanto debole e pauroso, prima della venuta dello Spirito, fosse questo pastore della Chiesa [Pietro], presso il cui corpo santissimo ora ci troviamo, ce lo dice quella serva che custodiva la porta. Turbato alla voce di una donna, per paura di morire, rinnegò la vita (*In 18,17*). E Pietro rinnegò, stando a terra, quando il ladrone diede la sua testimonianza stando sulla croce (*Lc 23,41 Lc 23,42*). Ma ascoltiamo come diventò quest'uomo così pauroso, dopo la venuta dello Spirito. Si raduna il consiglio dei magistrati e degli anziani, e agli apostoli, dopo che sono stati flagellati, viene ingiunto di non predicare più nel nome di Gesù. Pietro risponde con grande autorità: "*Bisogna obbedire a Dio piuttosto che agli uomini*" (*Ac 5,29*). E ancora: "*Se sia giusto innanzi a Dio obbedire a voi più che a lui giudicatelo voi stessi; noi non possiamo tacere quello che abbiamo visto e ascoltato*" (*Ac 4,19-20*). *Ma essi se ne andarono dalla presenza del sinedrio lieti di essere stati giudicati degni di patire oltraggi per il nome di Gesù*" (*Ac 5,41*). Ecco, quel Pietro che prima temeva davanti a una parola, ora gode sotto le percosse. E colui che aveva avuto paura della voce di una serva, dopo la venuta dello Spirito Santo, pur flagellato umilia la potenza dei principi. Piace alzare gli occhi della fede sulla virtù di questo Artista e considerare qua e là i padri del Vecchio e del Nuovo Testamento. Ecco che, aperti questi stessi occhi della fede, io osservo David, Amos, Daniele, Pietro, Paolo, Matteo, e voglio considerare quale Artista sia questo Spirito Santo, ma mentre sono intento a ciò sento che non riesco. Infatti [questo Artista] riempie un fanciullo che suonava la cetra e lo fa diventare il Salmista (*1S 16,18*), riempie un pastore d'armenti che sbucciava fichi selvatici, e ne fa un profeta (*Am 7,14*); riempie un fanciullo dedito all'astinenza, e ne fa un giudice di vecchi (cf. s); riempie un pescatore, e ne fa un predicatore (*Mt 4,19*); riempie un persecutore, e ne fa il Dottore delle genti (cf. *Ac 9,1s*); riempie un pubblicano, e ne fa un evangelista (*Lc 5,27-28*). Quale Artista è questo Spirito! Tutto ciò che vuole avviene senza indugio. Appena tocca la mente, insegna, e il suo solo tocco è già insegnare.
