I want to thank all the parishioners of St. Mary Immaculate Parish for their ongoing support during this period of great uncertainty. It has been wonderful to see so many of you at Mass since we re-opened in June. I am especially grateful to the volunteers who have helped ensure our church is a safe place to gather - they have done incredible work!

As you know, York Region is now in the "red zone" as identified by the Province of Ontario. Local medical officers of health have also made strong recommendations for places of worship to reduce their capacity in order to minimize potential transmission.

As of Tuesday, November 24th, attendance at all liturgical celebrations will be limited to 50 worshippers in the entire building at one time. These 50 worshippers do not include clergy and volunteers who are involved in ministry during the Mass. This attendance limit applies to all sacramental celebrations - Mass, Baptisms, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, Weddings and Funerals.

Also, all non-essential meetings in the parish will continue virtually via the Parish zoom account. The Parish office will continue to be open 3 days per week, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 8:30 am to noon by appointment only.

To help address the new capacity limits, Mass registration will now be required for weekday Masses similar to the weekend Masses. Registration is available on our website at www.smirh.com or you may contact the parish office.

Registration for the weekend Masses and the upcoming weekday Masses ends every Friday at 4:00 pm. Please allow the reopening team members to direct you to your seat and follow their direction for Communion.

If you are unable to join us in person you can visit our You Tube channel, SMI Parish, for livestream Sunday Mass at 11:00 am.
