WINTER COAT DRIVE – THANK YOU!

This year's Winter Coat Drive was a collaboration between the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul, the Salvation Army and St. Paul's Lutheran Church. Many of the York South SSVP Conferences and individual Vincentians organized collections from schools and from friends, neighbours, and businesses. Carloads of coats, hats, scarves and even handmade blankets arrived from across York Region. Some of our Vincentians helped with distribution and assisted our Neighbours as they 'shopped' for coats. I am sure that everyone would agree about the tremendous job that the Salvation Army did in sorting and organizing the distribution!

Mary Halbert from the Salvation Army sent the following 'thank you' to everyone who participated and volunteered:

*"Over the three days of distribution we gave out **442 winter coats** which was comparable to last year (464 coats), plus the same amount again of fall jackets, sweaters, hats, scarves, gloves & a few boots. Overall we met with & served **135 families**. (139 last year)*

It was quite an operation to collect, sort, display, assist with shopping & clear up! There were 35 different individuals who came to help.

It was also heartwarming to see three of our Richmond Hill churches (Society of St Vincent de Paul at St Mary's Immaculate Church, St Paul's Lutheran Church, Salvation Army Richmond Hill Community Church) serving our community together in this program and being the hands and feet of our Lord Jesus Christ. "We are one in the Spirit, we are one in the Lord." The Catholic School Board schools under the encouragement of Louise Wilson donated most of the fabulous amount of coats, and Pastor Annette at St Paul's Lutheran Church was so gracious in lending us their program space for 8 days.

We want to sincerely thank all of you who volunteered your time in the Winter Coat Program. It made such a big impact on our community who needed help this Fall with acquiring warm coats for their families.

The "left over" coats are still available for needy families at the Salvation Army office until Christmas, and the rest will be distributed among various shelters.

Thank you again for all your willing help. Today I read this verse from Proverbs 19:17, "Whoever is kind to the poor lends to the Lord, and he will reward them for what they have done." May He restore you and bless you in the days ahead." Mary

Seeing this program continue as a community project is truly inspiring and we hope to see it flourish in years to come.
