THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, Nov. 9th, Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. This is Rome's oldest and highest ranking Church, the Pope's Cathedral Church as Bishop of Rome. In celebrating its dedication, we acknowledge the Holy Father's universal jurisdiction over the Church.

Tuesday, Nov. 10th, St. Leo the Great, Pope, Doctor. St. Leo became Pope in the year 440. His defense of the faith, the Church's unity and his concern for the faithful deservedly won for him the title, "the Great." He died in 461.

Wednesday, Nov. 11th, St. Martin of Tours, Bishop. St. Martin gave up a military career and became a monk in France. He was known for his sanctity and zeal as a pastor. He died in 397.

Thursday, Nov., 12th, St. Josaphat, Bishop, Martyr. St. Josaphat was born in the Ukraine of Orthodox parents about the year 1580. He embraced the Catholic faith becoming a Basilian monk. He became Archbishop of Polock & was martyred in 1623.



As members of our Catholic community, we regularly benefit from the tireless service of our priests. The response to the Family of Faith campaign has been terrific! The Family of Faith campaign will support parishes and

provide assistance in other areas too. Some parish communities face daunting expenditures to maintain facilities that are safe and meet current standards. Some parishes do not have the financial capacity to preserve their historic sacred spaces. Collectively we share the responsibility to ensure the proper care of these churches continue for years to come.

We also want to ensure our places of worship are accessible to those with special needs. In compliance with new government regulations requiring accessible entrances, washrooms and access to church halls and offices, many of our older buildings require extensive capital work to ensure the safety and comfort of parishioners and visitors.

We also want to continue to the growth that has been happening in the Archdiocese of Toronto. Fourteen churches have been constructed and opened since 2000. Our growing family of faith means we expect this patter to continue. The cost of new churches continues to rise and this campaign will help to provide financing through the Archdiocese on a more timely basis, allowing construction earlier in the process.

PROJECT HOPE In response to this global humanitarian crisis, Cardinal Thomas Collins has announced today the launch of "Project Hope," a special emergency appeal to respond to the tragic situation. The 100-day campaign will have a target of \$3 million and a goal of settling 100 refugee families within the Greater Toronto Area as soon as possible. The effort will also require 100 volunteer committees to assist with settlement services. The archdiocese will prioritize refugees fleeing war and violence in areas of greatest need, including Syria and Iraq, regardless of religious affiliation. We continue to pray for all those suffering, mindful of our call to welcome the stranger in our midst. 




