Molto lascia chi non trattiene niente per sé; molto lascia chi abbandona completamente tutto quel che possiede. Nessuno dica quindi, allorché vede che altri hanno lasciato tutto: imiterei volentieri questi spregiatori del mondo, però non ho nulla da lasciare. Infatti, fratelli, anche voi rinunciate a molto, se rinunciate ai desideri terreni. Lasciando il poco che possedete, è quanto basta per far contento il Signore: egli guarda il vostro cuore, non il vostro patrimonio. Il Regno di Dio, invero, non ha prezzo, però esso vale tutto ciò che uno possiede. Nel caso di Zaccheo, esso valse la metà dei suoi beni, perché l'altra metà se la riservò per restituire il quadruplo a quelli che aveva defraudato, nel caso di Pietro e Andrea, valse le reti e la barca; per la vedova, valse solo due spiccioli; per un altro sarà valso magari un semplice bicchiere d'acqua fresca (Gregorio Magno, *Omellie sul vangelo*).

Se si legge la seconda lettura nella luce del Vangelo, si rende chiaro l'irripetibile sacrificio di Cristo - in luogo dei molti sacrifici di

animali dell'Antico Patto - come il dono della cosa estrema dietro cui non resta più nulla. Il suo sacrificio viene anche espressamente paragonato con la morte dell'uomo: come questa è assolutamente irripetibile (di trasmutazione delle anime non si parla mai nella Bibbia), così anche questo sacrificio, che basta ad espiare i peccati del mondo una volta per tutte. E dietro l'autodedizione di Gesù si intravede il sacrificio del Padre, che è senz'altro paragonabile alla povera vedova nel Vangelo: anch'egli getta tutto ciò che ha, la persona più cara non solo, anche quella più necessaria, nel tesoro: Dio tanto ha amato il mondo da dare il suo unico Figlio (Hans Urs Von Balthasar, *Luce della Parola*, 248).

Ogni giorno del nostro pellegrinaggio sulla terra è un dono sempre nuovo del tuo amore per noi, è un pegno della vita immortale, poiché possediamo fin da ora le primizie del tuo Spirito, nel quale hai risuscitato Gesù Cristo dai morti, e viviamo nell'attesa che si compia la beata speranza nella Pasqua eterna del tuo regno (prefazio del tempo ordinario, VI).
