A VISIT TO THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

Guardian Angel: Jesus is very lonely. He is weary waiting for those whom He loves, but who forget Him. Let us visit Him. Walk gently: the Church is a holy place; God is here. Kneel and adore Him. It delights the Heart of Jesus to have you near Him. Listen to His sweet voice.

JESUS: My child, you need not know much in order to please Me: only love Me dearly. Speak to Me as you would talk to your mother, if she had taken you in her arms. Have you no one to recommend to Me? Tell Me the names of your relatives, of your friends: after each name add what you wish Me to do for them. Ask a great deal: I love generous hearts that forget themselves for others.

Tell Me about the poor whom you want to help, the sick whom you have seen suffer, the sinner whom you would convert, the persons who are alienated from you, and whose affections you wish to win back. For all recite a fervent prayer. Remind Me that I have promised to grant every prayer that comes from the heart; and surely the prayers are heartfelt which we say for those whom we love.

Have you no favours to ask for yourself? Recall all the needs of your soul and tell them to Me. Tell Me simply how self-indulgent you are, how proud, how sensitive, how selfish, how cowardly, how idle; ask Me to help you to improve. Poor child! Do not blush! There are in heaven many saints who had the same faults as you; they prayed to Me, and, little by little, they were cured. Do not hesitate to ask for the goods of body and mind - for health, memory, success. I can give you everything, and I always grant requests for gifts that will make souls more holy. What do you want today, My child? Oh, if you knew how I long to do you good!

Have you no plans to interest you? Tell me about them. Do they concern your vocation? What do you think of? What would you like? Are you planning some pleasure for one dear to you? What do you wish to do for them?

And have you no thoughts of zeal for Me? Do you not care to do a little good for the souls of those whom you love, and who perhaps, forget Me? Tell Me who interests you, what motives urge you, what means you wish to take to do them good.

Confide in Me your failures. I will show you the cause. Whom do you wish to see interested in your works? I Am the master of all hearts and I lead them gently where I please. I will place about you those who are necessary to you. Never fear!

Have you nothing to trouble you? My child, tell Me of all your little crosses. Who has pained you? Who has wounded your self-love? Who has treated you contemptuously? Tell Me all, and then say you forgive and forget; and I will give you My blessing.

Do you dread something painful? Is there in your soul a vague fear which seems unreasonable,

and yet torments you? Trust fully in My providence. I Am here, I see everything; I will not leave you.

Are there about you friends who seem less kind than formerly, who neglect you through indifference or forgetfulness without your having consciously done anything to wound them? Pray for them, and I will restore them to you, if their companionship is good for you.

Have you no joys to tell Me? Why not confide to Me your pleasures? Tell Me what has happened since yesterday to console you, to make you happy, to give you joy. An unexpected visit has done you good: a fear was suddenly dispelled: you have met with unlooked-for success; you have received some mark of affection; some trial has left you stronger than you supposed. All these things, My child, I obtained for you. Why are you not grateful? Why do you not say 'thank You'? Gratitude insures further benefits, and the benefactor loves to be reminded of his bounty.

Have you no promises to make Me? You know I search in hearts. Men are deceived, but not I: be frank. Are you resolved to avoid that occasion of sin, to give up the object which leads you astray, to withdraw your friendship from that person who is irreligious, and whose presence disturbs the peace of your soul? Will you go at once and be kind to that companion who offended you?

Well, My child, go now and resume your daily work. Be silent, modest, patient, charitable, prayerful. Love the Blessed Virgin dearly; and tomorrow bring Me a heart even more devoted and loving. Tomorrow I shall have new favours for you.

"Annunciamo la venuta di Cristo, non la prima solo, ma anche una seconda, molto più bella della prima. La prima fu una manifestazione di pazienza, la seconda porta il diadema della regalità divina. Tutto è per lo più duplice nel Signore: doppia la nascita, una da Dio prima dei secoli, una dalla Vergine alla fine dei secoli; doppia la discesa, una oscura, l'altra piena di splendore. Non fermiamoci dunque alla prima venuta soltanto, ma aspettiamo anche la seconda. Viene il Signore nostro Gesù Cristo dai cieli; viene nella gloria alla fine di questo mondo, nell'ultimo giorno, perché ci sarà la fine di questo mondo e il mondo creato sarà rinnovato. Infatti, la corruzione, il furto, l'adulterio e ogni specie di delitto si è effuso sulla terra, e nel mondo si è mescolato sangue al sangue. Affinché perciò questa mirabile dimora non resti oppressa dall'iniquità, se ne va questo mondo perché ne sia inaugurato uno migliore (Cirillo di Gerusalemme, *Catechesi* 15)."

"E' Cristo che giudica. Significa che è la grazia a giudicare, è il perdono, è l'amore. Chi si aggrappa alla grazia è già assolto. Chi invece vuole appellarsi alle proprie opere, su queste sarà giudicato da Cristo e condannato. Noi però dobbiamo rallegrarci di quel giorno, non dobbiamo tremare o trepidare, ma abbandonarci con fiducia alla sua mano. Lutero ha parlato dell'"amato" ultimo giorno. Vieni, ultimo giorno! Con gioia ti attendiamo, perché vedremo il Signore misericordioso, afferreremo la sua mano, ed egli ci amerà. Cos'è in definitiva il "bene" e il "male" di cui Cristo ci chiede conto? Il bene non è nient'altro che il nostro chiedergli la sua grazia e afferrarla; il male nient'altro che la paura e la pretesa di stare da noi stessi dinanzi a Dio, la pretesa di autogiustificarci. Fare penitenza significa allora restare in questa continua conversione dalle proprie opere alla misericordia di Dio. "Conversione! Conversione!", ci grida con gioia la Bibbia intera. Conversione, ma verso dove? Verso la grazia eterna di Dio. Egli non ci lascia, il suo cuore trabocca di amore per noi, sue creature, perché ci ama oltre misura. Sì, egli ci userà misericordia. E allora vieni, o ultimo giorno! Signore Gesù, fa' che siamo pronti. Noi ci ralleghiamo (Dietrich Bonhoeffer, Memoria e fedeltà - predica, domenica 19 nov. 1933)."

"Cerchiamo di non amare il mondo; esso opprime coloro che lo amano, non li conduce al bene. Bisogna sforzarsi che non ci faccia prigionieri piuttosto che temere che perisca. Ecco, il mondo perisce, ma il ristiano persiste, perché Cristo non perisce. Perché mai, infatti, dice il Signore: Rallegratevi, poiché io ho vinto il mondo? (Gv 16, 33). Potremmo rispondergli, se fosse consentito: "Ma sei tu che devi rallegrarti. Se hai vinto tu, sei tu che devi rallegrarti. Perché dovremmo rallegrarci noi?". Per qual motivo ci dice: Rallegratevi, se non perché è per noi ch'egli ha vinto, è per noi ch'egli ha lottato? In qual modo infatti ha lottato? Per il fatto che ha preso la natura umana. Escludi la sua nascita dalla Vergine, escludi il fatto che si spogliò della sua divinità prendendo la natura di schiavo e divenendo simile agli uomini e per il suo comportamento fu riconosciuto come un vero uomo; se escludi ciò, come sarebbe stata possibile la lotta, il

combattimento, la prova attraverso le sofferenze, la vittoria non preceduta dal combattimento? (Agostino, Dal Discorso 97, 1. 3-4).”
