JUBILEE OF MERCY in the Archdiocese of Toronto.

The Jubilee of Mercy was announced by Pope Francis as a year to be lived intensely in each local Church throughout the world, allowing every person to encounter the mercy of God. The most evident sign of this pastoral care is the chance to open a Door of Mercy in every diocese. These doors, analogous to the Holy Doors of the Papal Basilicas in Rome, will allow people who cannot travel to Rome to make a Jubilee pilgrimage. After the solemn inauguration of the Holy Year – marked by the opening of the Holy Door of Saint Peter’s Basilica on December 8, 2015 – all locally-designated Churches throughout the world will open their own Doors of Mercy in communion with the Church of Rome as part of the Eucharistic celebration of the Third Sunday of Advent or Gaudete Sunday. The Holy Father has asked that special indulgences be available for the Faithful throughout the Year of Mercy (Dec. 8, 2015 – Nov. 20, 2016).

How to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence: For those able to make a pilgrimage to one of the Jubilee churches in Rome, that is certainly an option. Otherwise, Cardinal Collins has designated seven churches within the Archdiocese of Toronto as Jubilee Churches, each with a Holy Door of Mercy. Going through one of these Holy Doors is a spiritual journey that shows, as the Holy Father said, “the deep desire for true conversion.” In addition to passing through a Holy Door, each pilgrim is to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, receive the Holy Eucharist while reflecting on God’s great gift of mercy, make a profession of faith (recite either the Apostles’ or the Nicene Creed), and pray for the Holy Father and for his intentions (an Our Father and a Hail Mary are recommended).

For those who are elderly, confined and the ill, Pope Francis said that they may obtain the indulgence by “living with faith and joyful hope this moment of trial” and by receiving the Eucharist or by attending Mass and community prayer, “even through the various means of communication” (for instance, a Mass offered on television).

Indulgences may be obtained for the dead by the carrying out of these same acts by the Faithful with the intention of offering the indulgence for someone who is deceased. And finally, for all Catholics, this jubilee indulgence may also be obtained when a member of the Faithful personally performs a spiritual or corporal work of mercy.

DO YOU HAVE QUESTIONS ABOUT THE FAMILY OF FAITH CAMPAIGN? FIND YOUR ANSWERS HERE!

1) What is the campaign goal? What will the money go toward? The financial goal for The Family of Faith campaign is \$105 million. Money collected from the campaign will be allocated to six areas: parish priorities, youth, young adult ministry and campus chaplaincies, developing leaders through Catholic formation and engagement, the restoration of St. Michael’s Cathedral, building new parish churches, and helping existing church properties.

2) How can I be sure that the money raised will be spent for the intended projects? A separate account has been established for money collected in the Family of Faith campaign. Funds will remain separate from other Archdiocesan funds and can be used only for the six purposes outlined above.

3) How are proceeds from parish campaigns allocated? Twenty-five per cent of funds raised, up to the parish’s financial goal, are reserved for parish priorities. Seventy-five per cent of funds are directed toward the Family of Faith campaign’s archdiocesan-wide priorities. When a parish surpasses its goal, seventy-five per cent of funds above the goal are allocated for parish use. Most donations are in the form of pledges, paid over time. Funds are credited to parish accounts two times per year, as pledges are fulfilled.

4) What will I be asked to give? How will I be contacted? While we do not know your unique financial situation, please consider a pledge to the campaign that best complements your past sacrificial giving. A pledge allows you to consider a larger commitment than a one-time gift, and can be paid over a period of five years. Every parishioner will be contacted either in person, by phone or by mail.

5) Why do I need to complete a pledge card? Each donor is asked to complete a pledge or commitment card, so that the gift is recorded and donors are reminded of subsequent payments on the schedule they request. A pledge is a good faith commitment, but is not binding. If circumstances change in the future, you can adjust your payment schedule or balance accordingly.

6) What about other priorities (eg. ShareLife) in my parish and in the archdiocese? How will they be affected? Parishioners across the Archdiocese of Toronto are being encouraged to commit to a sacrificial gift to the Family of Faith campaign. As the gift to the campaign is sacrificial, parishioners are asked to maintain their commitment to other priorities, including ShareLife and their weekly parish offertory collections. Large capital campaigns can have a short term impact on annual fundraising campaigns like ShareLife and this will be monitored throughout the Family of Faith campaign.

È precisamente agli appartenenti al suo regno che egli si riferisce quando dice: *Voi non siete del mondo, ma io vi ho scelti dal mondo* (Gv 15.19). Erano dunque del mondo quando ancora non facevano parte del suo regno, e appartenevano al principe del mondo. È quindi del mondo tutto ciò che di umano è stato sì creato dal vero Dio, ma che è stato generato dalla stirpe corrotta e dannata di Adamo; è diventato però regno di Dio, e non è più di questo mondo, tutto ciò che in Cristo è stato rigenerato. È in questo modo che Dio ci ha sottratti al potere delle tenebre e ci ha trasferiti nel Regno del Figlio del suo amore (Col 1.13) (Agostino, *Comm. a Gv* 15.2-3).

La croce di Cristo, il mistero della morte e resurrezione, sarà sempre il principio e la fine, l'alfa e l'omega della vita della Chiesa, ma anche della nostra vita personale, della storia del nostro mondo. Chi vuol vivere deve rimettere la spada nel fodero, deve "perdere" la propria vita per poterla "salvare", deve rinunciare a se stesso e caricarsi della propria croce (cfr Lc 9.23). (...) Questa libertà vertiginosa della morte, questa potenza illimitata del non riporre più fiducia in se stessi può essere vissuta solamente nello spazio di una vicenda di amore. Ogni amore autentico è una morte, è un disperare di tutto ciò che non è l'Amato. Ecco perché il mistero della morte e della resurrezione può essere vissuto unicamente se riferito al volto dello Sposo della Chiesa. È lo Sposo a fare il primo passo in questa vicenda di amore: "È lui che per primo si è innamorato di noi... di noi che eravamo suoi nemici e avversari... E non solo si è innamorato, ma per noi si è umiliato, è stato schiaffeggiato, crocifisso, è stato annoverato fra i morti e, in tutto questo, ha manifestato il suo amore per noi" (Fozio). Evitare questa morte con qualche stratagemma terreno, con la spada – non importa quale – di una difesa a breve respiro, significa escludersi dalla camera nuziale... (C. Yannaras, *L'oreille de Malchus* pp. 198-99).

"Annunciamo la venuta di Cristo, non la prima solo, ma anche una seconda, molto più bella della prima. La prima fu una manifestazione di pazienza, la seconda porta il diadema della regalità divina. Tutto è per lo più duplice nel Signore: doppia la nascita, una da Dio prima dei secoli, una dalla Vergine alla fine dei secoli; doppia la discesa, una oscura, l'altra piena di splendore. Non fermiamoci dunque alla prima venuta soltanto, ma aspettiamo anche la seconda. 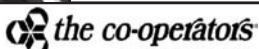
