## JESUS CHRIST THE UNIVERSAL KING!

... Only the one who "came from the Father" can return to the Father: Christ Jesus. "No one has ascended into heaven but He who descended from heaven, the Son of man." Left to its own natural powers humanity does not have access to the "Father's house," to God's life and happiness. Only Christ can open to man such access that we, His members, might have confidence that we too shall go where He, our Head and our Source, has preceded us.

"And I, when I Am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to Myself." The lifting up of Jesus on the cross signifies and announces His lifting up by His Ascension into heaven, and indeed begins it. Jesus Christ, the one priest of the new and eternal Covenant, "entered, not into a sanctuary made by human hands ... but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf." There Christ permanently exercises His priesthood, for He "always lives to make intercession" for "those who draw near to God through Him." As "high priest of the good things to come" He is the center and the principal actor of the liturgy that honors the Father in heaven.

Henceforth Christ is *seated at the right hand of the Father*: "By 'the Father's right hand' we understand the glory and honor of divinity, where He who exists as Son of God before all ages, indeed as God, of one being with the Father, is seated bodily after He became incarnate and His flesh was glorified."

Being seated at the Father's right hand signifies the inauguration of the Messiah's kingdom, the fulfillment of the prophet Daniel's vision concerning the Son of man: "To Him was given dominion and glory and kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him; His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom one that shall not be destroyed."

### Solennità di Cristo Re – 23 novembre 2014

"Di conseguenza, se ritenete di dovermi ascoltare in qualcosa, servi di Cristo, e fratelli, e coeredi, visitiamo Cristo, tutto il tempo che ci è possibile, curiamo Cristo, nutriamo Cristo, vestiamo Cristo, riuniamo Cristo, onoriamo Cristo, non solo alla mensa, come qualcuno, né con gli unguenti, come Maria, né soltanto al sepolcro, come Giuseppe d'Arimatea, né con le cose che riguardano la sepoltura, come quel Nicodemo che amava Cristo solo a

metà, né infine con l'oro, l'incenso e la mirra come i Magi prima ancora di tutti coloro che abbiamo nominato, ma poiché da tutti il Signore esige la misericordia e non il sacrificio, e la cui misericordia supera le migliaia di pingui agnelli, e questa portiamogli attraverso i poveri prostrati a terra in questo giorno, affinché quando saremo usciti di qui, essi ci ricevano nei tabernacoli eterni nello stesso Cristo Signore nostro, a cui è la gloria nei secoli. Amen (S. Gregorio Nazianzeno, Oratio XIV de pauper. amore, 27 s., 39 s.).

"La Chiesa è depositaria del mistero di Cristo: lo è in tutta umiltà e senza ombra di orgoglio o arroganza, perché si tratta del dono massimo che ha ricevuto senza alcun merito e che è chiamata ad offrire gratuitamente all'umanità di ogni epoca, come orizzonte di significato e di salvezza. Non è una filosofia, non è una gnosi, sebbene comprenda anche la sapienza e la conoscenza. È il mistero di Cristo; è Cristo stesso, Logos incarnato, morto e risorto, costituito Re dell'universo. Come non provare un empito di entusiasmo colmo di gratitudine per essere stati ammessi a contemplare lo splendore di questa rivelazione? Come non sentire al tempo stesso la gioia e la responsabilità di servire questo Re, di testimoniare con la vita e con la parola la sua signoria? Questo è, in modo particolare, il nostro compito, venerati Fratelli Cardinali: annunciare al mondo la verità di Cristo, speranza per ogni uomo e per l'intera famiglia umana. Sulla scia del Concilio Ecumenico Vaticano II, i miei venerati Predecessori, i Servi di Dio Paolo VI, Giovanni Paolo I e Giovanni Paolo II, sono stati autentici araldi della regalità di Cristo nel mondo contemporaneo. Ed è per me motivo di consolazione poter contare sempre su di voi, sia collegialmente che singolarmente, per portare a compimento anch'io tale compito fondamentale del ministero petrino. Strettamente unito a questa missione è un aspetto che vorrei, in conclusione, toccare e affidare alla vostra preghiera: la pace tra tutti i discepoli di Cristo, come segno della pace che Gesù è venuto a instaurare nel mondo. Abbiamo ascoltato nell'inno cristologico la grande notizia: a Dio è piaciuto "rappacificare" l'universo mediante la croce di Cristo (cfr Col 1,20)! Ebbene, la Chiesa è quella porzione di umanità in cui si manifesta già la regalità di Cristo, che ha come manifestazione privilegiata la pace. È la nuova Gerusalemme, ancora imperfetta perché pellegrina nella storia, ma in grado di anticipare, in qualche modo, la Gerusalemme celeste. Qui possiamo, infine, riferirci al testo del Salmo responsoriale, il 121: appartiene ai cosiddetti "canti delle ascensioni" ed è l'inno di gioia dei pellegrini che, giunti alle porte della città santa, le rivolgono il saluto di pace: shalom! Secondo un'etimologia popolare Gerusalemme veniva interpretata proprio come "città della pace", quella pace che il Messia, figlio di Davide, avrebbe instaurato nella pienezza dei tempi. In Gerusalemme noi riconosciamo la figura della Chiesa, sacramento di Cristo e del suo Regno (Benedetto XVI, Cristo Re, 2007)".
