THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Wednesday, November 30th, St. Andrew, Apostle. St. Andrew was a disciple of John the Baptist before he became a follower of Jesus, to Whom he also brought his brother Peter. After Pentecost, he preached the Gospel in many lands and was put to death by crucifixion in Achaia. **Please note that the Saturday morning Mass will be Tridentine Mass. Una Voce, the Traditional Mass Society will be holding their Annual General Meeting in our parish on this day. We welcome them to our parish.**

First Thursday of the Month, December 1st. We honour our Lord Jesus Christ, Eternal High Priest.

First Friday of the Month, December 2nd. We honour the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Saturday, December 3rd, St. Francis Xavier, Priest St. Francis Xavier was one of the first Jesuits. He was ordained a priest in Venice and sailed for the East Indies in 1541. In 1542, he landed in Goa and from there set out to preach the Gospel in different lands. He died in, China in 1552. He is patron of the missions.

First Saturday of the Month. We honour the Immaculate Heart of Mary

ADVENT

When the Church celebrates *the liturgy of Advent* each year, she makes present this ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for His second coming. By celebrating the precursor's birth and martyrdom, the Church unites herself to his desire: "He must increase, but I must decrease." (*Catechism of the Catholic Church #524*)

Advent has a twofold character. As a season to prepare us for Christmas when Christ's first coming to us is remembered: as a season when that remembrance directs the mind and heart to await Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. Advent is thus a period of devout and joyful expectation.

From December 17th on, there is a notable shift in emphasis as the events immediately preceding the Lord's birth are present in the gospel readings while the first readings proclaim the most important Messianic prophecies.

During Advent, each Sunday's gospel has a specific theme. The Old Testament readings, especially those taken from Isaiah, are prophecies about the Messiah and messianic times. The selections from the writings of the apostles present exhortations and instructions on different themes of this season.

ST. ANDREW CHRISTMAS NOVENA

(starts Nov. 30th)

Hail and blessed be the hour and moment in which the Son of God was born of the most pure Virgin Mary, at midnight, in Bethlehem, in piercing cold. In that hour, vouchsafe, O my God, to hear my prayer and grant my desires, through the merits of our Saviour Jesus Christ, and of His Blessed Mother. Amen.

27 novembre 2016 - 1a di Avvento

Così il Verbo ha nascosto a noi la fine di tutte le cose; dato che quel giorno è incerto e viviamo nell'attesa di esso, cammineremo ogni giorno, come chiamati, tutti protesi verso quelle cose che per noi sono le più importanti, dimenticando le secondarie (cfr Fil 3,13). Chi infatti, avendo conosciuto il giorno ultimo della fine, non trascurerà il tempo intermedio? E al contrario, chi, non conoscendolo, non si preparerà ogni giorno? Per questo il Salvatore ha detto: *vegliate, perché non sapete in quale tempo verrà il Signore* (Atanasio, *Discorsi contro gli ariani* 3,49).

Meditando l'Avvento passato e l'Avvento futuro, impariamo a riconoscere l'Avvento presente, che si situa in ogni momento della nostra vita di pellegrini terreni. Raggiungiamo la consapevolezza del fatto che ogni momento del tempo è un momento di giudizio, che Cristo sta passando e che noi siamo giudicati dalla maggiore o minore coscienza di questo suo passaggio. Se ci uniamo a lui e ci mettiamo in cammino con lui, verso il suo regno, il giudizio diventa salvezza per noi. Ma se lo trascuriamo e lo lasciamo andare oltre, la nostra indifferenza diventa la nostra condanna. La meditazione del primo Avvento ci dà la speranza nella promessa che ci è stata fatta (T. Merton, *Stagioni liturgiche* p. 74).

Il Signore non viene nel rumore, il Signore non trova posto nella frenesia e nello stordimento. E' venuto nella pace e per la pace. E' una parola questa così usata da diventare banale: è chiamato «pace» un equilibrio di paura; si parla di pace in una società intessuta di violenza e di oppressione dell'uomo sull'uomo. Si dissolve oggi anche la pace più semplice, quella della famiglia. Solo Cristo può riunire gli uomini dispersi dall'egoismo e fare di tutti un unico popolo pacifico in cammino verso il monte del suo Tempio. L'ora di Dio giunge a noi perché ogni istante della nostra vita contiene l'eternità di Dio. Non bisogna basarsi unicamente sulla saggezza umana, e neppure aspettarsi un intervento massiccio da parte di Dio. É al presente che viene donata la salvezza. Ogni scelta che si fa nel presente fra la luce e le tenebre è un segno della venuta del Figlio dell'uomo. L'assemblea eucaristica è la Chiesa in stato di attesa e di vigilanza, che impara a leggere, nell'«oggi» della propria storia, la venuta del Signore come momento di salvezza.
