ADVENT

When the Church celebrates the liturgy of Advent each year, she makes present this ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for His second coming. By celebrating the precursor's birth and martyrdom, the Church unites herself to his desire: "He must increase, but I must decrease."

Catechism of the Catholic Church #524

Advent has a twofold character. As a season to prepare us for Christmas when Christ's first coming to us is remembered: as a season when that remembrance directs the mind and heart to await Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. Advent is thus a period of devout and joyful expectation.

From December 17th on, there is a notable shift in emphasis as the events immediately preceding the Lord's birth are present in the gospel readings while the first readings proclaim the most important Messianic prophecies.

During Advent, each Sunday's gospel has a specific theme. The Old Testament readings, especially those taken from Isaiah, are prophecies about the Messiah and messianic times. The selections from the writings of the apostles present exhortations and instructions on different themes of this season.

<u>ADVENT WREATH</u> Customarily the Advent wreath is constructed of a circle of evergreen branches into which are inserted four candles. The candles represent the four weeks of Advent. The rose candle is lit on the Third Sunday of Advent, also known as Gaudete Sunday.

THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, November 30th, St. Andrew, Apostle St. Andrew was a disciple of John the Baprist before he became a follower of Jesus, to Whom he also brought his brother Peter. After Pentecost, he preached the Gospel in many lands and was put to death by crucifixion in Achaia.

Thursday, December 3rd, St. Francis Xavier, Priest St. Francis Xavier was one of the first Jesuits. He was ordained a priest in Venice and sailed for the East Indies in 1541. In 1542, he landed in Goa and from there set out to preach the Gospel in different lands. He died in, China in 1552. He is patron of the missions.

Friday, December 4th, First Friday of the Month We honour the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Most Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration from 8:30 a.m. until just before the 7 p.m. Mass. Through our consecration to Her, Mary enables us to be closer to God and to receive more of God's blessings.

The communal consecration will take place at the 7:00 p.m. Mass, on Tues. Dec. 8th right after Holy Communion. *Fr. Steven*


