**ADVENT**

When the Church celebrates *the liturgy of Advent* each year, she makes present this ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for His second coming. By celebrating the precursor's birth and martyrdom, the Church unites herself to his desire: "He must increase, but I must decrease."

**Catechism of the Catholic Church #524**

Advent has a twofold character. As a season to prepare us for Christmas when Christ's first coming to us is remembered: as a season when that remembrance directs the mind and heart to await Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. Advent is thus a period of devout and joyful expectation.

From December 17<sup>th</sup> on, there is a notable shift in emphasis as the events immediately preceding the Lord's birth are present in the gospel readings while the first readings proclaim the most important Messianic prophecies.

During Advent, each Sunday's gospel has a specific theme. The Old Testament readings, especially those taken from Isaiah, are prophecies about the Messiah and messianic times. The selections from the writings of the apostles present exhortations and instructions on different themes of this season.

**ADVENT WREATH** Customarily the Advent wreath is constructed of a circle of evergreen branches into which are inserted four candles. The candles represent the four weeks of Advent. The rose candle is lit on the Third Sunday of Advent, also known as Gaudete Sunday.

**THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK**

**Monday, November 30<sup>th</sup>, St. Andrew, Apostle** St. Andrew was a disciple of John the Baptist before he became a follower of Jesus, to Whom he also brought his brother Peter. After Pentecost, he preached the Gospel in many lands and was put to death by crucifixion in Achaia.

**Thursday, December 3<sup>rd</sup>, St. Francis Xavier, Priest** St. Francis Xavier was one of the first Jesuits. He was ordained a priest in Venice and sailed for the East Indies in 1541. In 1542, he landed in Goa and from there set out to preach the Gospel in different lands. He died in, China in 1552. He is patron of the missions.

The Most Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration from 8:30 a.m. until just before the 7 p.m. Mass. **A Warning and an Opportunity**

In 1917 the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to 3 children in Fatima, Portugal. On Oct. 13<sup>th</sup> of that year 70,000 people witnessed the miracle of the sun during Our Lady's final public appearance to the children. This extraordinary event was recorded in newspapers worldwide. Obviously God was, and is, trying to get people's attention by means of such a huge miraculous event. Our Lady of Fatima warned that if people do not stop offending God by their irreligious life styles and their lack of faith, mankind will bring greater and greater tribulations upon itself and more and more disasters upon the world. The Blessed Virgin Mary also stated that, "God wishes to establish in the world devotion to My Immaculate Heart," and She asked that the Pope, in union with all the bishops of the world, consecrate Russia to Her Immaculate Heart. She warned that if this is not done Russia will continue to spread its communist ideals throughout the world; its atheistic materialism and contempt for human life. Our Lady also said that, "In the end, My Immaculate Heart will triumph." In other words, Russia will be converted, people everywhere will turn back to God, and there will be an era of peace. This is yet to happen!

Various popes have, individually, consecrated the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. It can be shown that this has resulted in a positive response from Heaven. Russia has fallen, but Russia and Communism are still a threat to world security. It appears that what is still lacking is that all the bishops unite with the pope in a communal act of consecration. A communal consecration would obtain God's blessings for the entire world and for all those specifically who participate in the consecration and are named in the consecration. The more people there are consecrating themselves to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the more God's blessings will flow upon everyone. And so, not only all the bishops, but all priests, all religious brothers and sisters, all the faithful can,

and should, participate in a communal act of consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Whatever we consecrate to Mary, She purifies, She sanctifies, She makes beautiful, and She offers to God. Through our consecration to Her, Mary enables us to be closer to God and to receive more of God's blessings.

We now have a wonderful opportunity to communally consecrate ourselves, our loved ones, and our parish to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. The communal consecration will take place at the 7:00 p.m. Mass, on Tues. Dec. 8<sup>th</sup> right after Holy Communion.

Non parlo di quello che in questo mondo è detto felicità, l'abbondanza dei beni temporali: non si tratta in tal caso di una tribolazione, ma di un sollievo alla nostra sofferenza. Di che sofferenza si tratta dunque? Di quella connessa col nostro esilio. Il fatto stesso che non siamo ancora con Dio, il fatto che viviamo qui, in mezzo alle tentazioni e alle persecuzioni, e non possiamo vivere senza timore, ecco la nostra tribolazione. Non è questa infatti la sicurezza che ci è stata promessa. Chi non proverà questa tribolazione connessa al suo esilio, non pensa al ritorno in patria. Ecco la tribolazione, fratelli. (...) Nessuno trova tale tribolazione, se non chi l'ha cercata... Loda colui che promette, loda colui che ti chiama, loda colui che esorta, loda colui che aiuta: e renditi conto della tribolazione nella quale sei posto. Invocalo: sarai liberato, lo glorificherai, resterai con lui (Agostino, *Esp. sui Salmi* I p. 1279)."

"La preghiera è incontro e unione tra l'uomo e Dio; sostiene il mondo e lo riconcilia con Dio, ottiene il perdono dei peccati, è difesa dalle tentazioni e dalle prove, placa ogni lotta interiore; è l'occupazione degli angeli, il nutrimento di ogni creatura spirituale.
