Ambrogio, La penitenza).

Qualunque cosa tu faccia di grande o di piccolo sulla terra, conserva la memoria della tua piccolezza. Per conto mio, io guardo come mia madre la terra [dalla quale sono stato tratto]. La terra, con la sua presenza continua e il suo richiamo incessante, è lalleata della ragione. Bella è lumiltà ed è conforme alla natura tutto ciò che ne ravviva il ricordo (Basilio di Cesarea, *Lorigne dell'uomo*).
