**POVERTY OF HEART**

Jesus enjoins His disciples to prefer Him to everything and everyone, and bids them "renounce all that [they have]" for His sake and that of the Gospel. Shortly before His passion He gave them the example of the poor widow of Jerusalem who, out of her poverty, gave all that she had to live on. The precept of detachment from riches is obligatory for entrance into the Kingdom of heaven.

All Christ's faithful are to "direct their affections rightly, lest they be hindered in their pursuit of perfect charity by the use of worldly things and by an adherence to riches which is contrary to the spirit of evangelical poverty."

"Blessed are the poor in spirit." The Beatitudes reveal an order of happiness and grace, of beauty and peace. Jesus celebrates the joy of the poor, to whom the Kingdom already belongs:

The Word speaks of voluntary humility as "poverty in spirit"; the Apostle gives an example of God's poverty when he says: "For your sakes he became poor."

The Lord grieves over the rich, because they find their consolation in the abundance of goods. "Let the proud seek and love earthly kingdoms, but blessed are the poor in spirit for theirs is the Kingdom of heaven." Abandonment to the providence of the Father in heaven frees us from anxiety about tomorrow. Trust in God is a preparation for the blessedness of the poor. They shall see God.

**THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK**

**Monday, Nov. 9<sup>th</sup>, Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome.** This is Rome's oldest and highest ranking Church, the Pope's Cathedral Church as Bishop of Rome. In celebrating its dedication, we acknowledge the Holy Father's universal jurisdiction over the Church.

**Tuesday, Nov. 10<sup>th</sup>, St. Leo the Great, Pope, Doctor.** St. Leo became Pope in the year 440. His defense of the faith, the Church's unity and his concern for the faithful deservedly won for him the title, "the Great." He died in 461.

**Wednesday, Nov. 11<sup>th</sup>, St. Martin of Tours, Bishop.** St. Martin gave up a military career and became a monk in France. He was known for his sanctity and zeal as a pastor. He died in 397.

**Thursday, Nov., 12<sup>th</sup>, St. Josaphat, Bishop, Martyr** St. Josaphat was born in the Ukraine of Orthodox parents about the year 1580. He embraced the Catholic faith becoming a Basilian monk. He became Archbishop of Polock and was martyred in 1623.

“Molto lascia chi non trattiene niente per sé; molto lascia chi abbandona completamente tutto quel che possiede. Nessuno dica quindi, allorché vede che altri hanno lasciato tutto: imiterei volentieri questi spregiatori del mondo, però non ho nulla da lasciare. Infatti, fratelli, anche voi rinunciate a molto, se rinunciate ai desideri terreni. Lasciando il poco che possedete, è quanto basta per far contento il Signore: egli guarda il vostro cuore, non il vostro patrimonio. Il Regno di Dio, invero, non ha prezzo, però esso vale tutto ciò che uno possiede. Nel caso di Zaccheo, esso valse la metà dei suoi beni, perché l'altra metà se la riservò per restituire il quadruplo a quelli che aveva defraudato, nel caso di Pietro e Andrea, valse le reti e la barca; per la vedova, valse solo due spiccioli; per un altro sarà valso magari un semplice bicchiere d'acqua fresca (Gregorio Magno, *Omelia sul vangelo*).”

“Se si legge la seconda lettura nella luce del Vangelo, si rende chiaro l'irripetibile sacrificio di Cristo - in luogo dei molti sacrifici di animali dell'Antico Patto - come il dono della cosa estrema dietro cui non resta più nulla. Il suo sacrificio viene anche espressamente paragonato con la morte dell'uomo: come questa è assolutamente irripetibile (di trasmigrazione delle anime non si parla mai nella Bibbia), così anche questo sacrificio, che basta ad espiare i peccati del mondo una volta per tutte. E dietro l'autodedizione di Gesù si intravede il sacrificio del Padre, che è senz'altro paragonabile alla povera vedova nel Vangelo: anch'egli getta tutto ciò che ha, la persona più cara non solo, anche quella più necessaria, nel tesoro: “Dio tanto ha amato il mondo da dare il suo unico Figlio” (Hans Urs Von Balthasar, *Luce della Parola*, 248).”

“Ogni giorno del nostro pellegrinaggio sulla terra è un dono sempre nuovo del tuo amore per noi, è un pegno della vita immortale, poiché possediamo fin da ora le primizie del tuo Spirito, nel quale hai risuscitato Gesù Cristo dai morti, e viviamo nell'attesa che si compia la beata speranza nella Pasqua eterna del tuo regno” (prefazio del tempo ordinario, VI).
