Thursday, October 15th, St. Teresa of Jesus, Virgin, Doctor. St. Teresa is the great reformer of the Carmelite Order. Her works of spirituality have merited for her the title of Doctor of the Church. She died in 1582.

Friday, Oct. 16, St. Marie-Marguerite d'Youville. On December 31, 1737, St. Marguerite and three companions committed themselves to serve the needy in Montreal. A year later, they began to live together in her house also to take in the destitute. Eventually, they came to be known as the Sisters of Charity of the General Hospital of Montreal. At her beatification in 1959, some 8000 in six autonomous congregations looked to her as foundress.






