

THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Wednesday, October 15th, St. Teresa of Jesus, Virgin, Doctor. St. Teresa is the great reformer of the Carmelite Order. Her works of spirituality have merited for her the title of Doctor of the Church. She died in 1582.

Thursday, Oct. 16, St. Marie-Marguerite d'Youville. On December 31, 1737, St. Marguerite and three companions committed themselves to serve the needy in Montreal. A year later, they began to live together in her house also to take in the destitute. Eventually, they came to be known as the Sisters of Charity of the General Hospital of Montreal. At her beatification in 1959, some 8000 in six autonomous congregations looked to her as foundress.

St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. Born in 1647 in France, St. Margaret Mary joined the Sisters of the Visitation at Paray-le-Monial where she received the revelations of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Through her, this devotion spread throughout the Church.

Friday, Oct. 17, St. Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop, Martyr. St. Ignatius was a successor of St. Peter as Bishop of Antioch. He was martyred in the year 107 by being thrown to wild animals.

Saturday, Oct. 18, St. Luke, Evangelist. St. Luke, born of pagan parents, converted to the Faith and became a fellow worker of the Apostle Paul. He compiled a Gospel and the <u>Acts of the Apostles</u>. The poet Dante described Luke as **"the scribe of the gentleness of Christ."**

"La veste nuziale sono i precetti del Signore e le opere che si compiono nello spirito della Legge e del Vangelo. Essi sono l'abito dell'uomo nuovo. Se qualcuno che porta il nome di cristiano, nel momento del giudizio sarà trovato senza l'abito di nozze, cioè l'abito dell'uomo celeste, e indosserà invece l'abito macchiato, ossia l'abito dell'uomo vecchio, costui sarà immediatamente ripreso e gli verrà detto: "Amico, come sei entrato?" Lo chiama amico perché è uno degli invitati alle nozze, e rimprovera la sua sfrontatezza perché col suo abito immonda ha contaminato la purezza delle nozze (Girolamo, Commento al Vangelo di Matteo)."

"Uniti dunque a Cristo nella chiesa e segnati dal sigillo dello Spirito Santo "che è caparra della nostra eredità" (Ef 1,14), siamo chiamati figli di Dio, e lo siamo realmente (cf. 1Gv 3,1); ma non siamo ancora apparsi con Cristo nella gloria (cf. Col 3,14), quando saremo simili a Dio perché lo vedremo così come egli è (cf. 1Gv 3,2). Pertanto, "finché abitiamo in questo corpo, siamo in esilio lontani dal Signore" (2Cor 5,6). Già in possesso delle primizie dello Spirito, gemiamo interiormente (cf. Rm 8,23) e desideriamo essere con Cristo (cf. Fil 1,23). È la carità che ci sprona a vivere più intensamente per lui che è morto e risorto per noi (cf. 2Cor 5,15). Per questo ci sforziamo di piacere in tutto al Signore (cf. 2Cor 5,9), e indossiamo l'armatura di Dio per poter resistere alle insidie del diavolo e tenergli fronte nel giorno della lotta (cf. Ef 6,11-13). Ma poiché non conosciamo né il giorno né l'ora, bisogna vegliare assiduamente, come ci ammonisce il Signore, affinché, terminato l'unico corso della nostra vita terrena (cf Eb 9,27), meritiamo di entrare con lui al banchetto nuziale ed essere annoverati fra i beati (cf. Mt 25,31-46), anziché essere mandati, perché servi malvagi e pigri (cf. Mt 25,26), nel fuoco eterno (cf. Mt 25,41), nelle tenebre esteriori dove "ci sarà pianto e disperazione" (Mt 22,23 e 25,30). Prima infatti di regnare con il Cristo glorioso, noi tutti compariremo "davanti al tribunale di Cristo, perché ciascuno riceva la ricompensa delle opere che avrà fatto nella sua vita, sia del bene che del male" (2Cor 5,10). Alla fine del mondo "chi avrà operato il bene risusciterà alla vita, chi invece avrà operato il male risusciterà per la condanna" (Gv 5,29; cf. Mt 25,46) (Conc. Vat. II, Cost. dogm. Lumen Gentium, 48)."
