

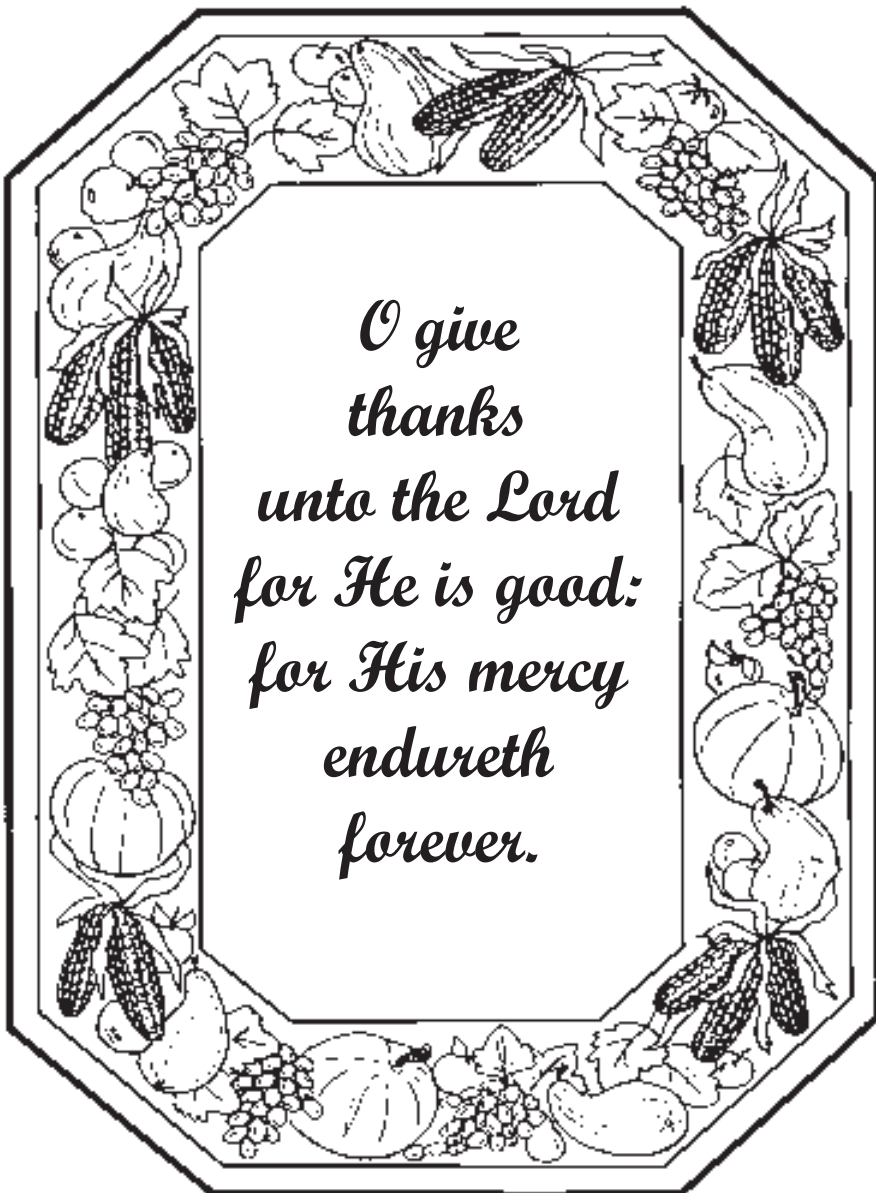

"Teacher, what good deed must I do, to have eternal life?" To the young man who asked this question, Jesus answers first by invoking the necessity to recognize God as the "One there is who is good," as the supreme Good and the source of all good. Then Jesus tells him: "If you would enter life, keep the commandments." And He cites for His questioner the precepts that concern love of neighbor: "You shall not kill, You shall not commit adultery, You shall not steal, You shall not bear false witness, Honor your father and mother." Finally Jesus sums up these commandments positively: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

To this first reply Jesus adds a second: "If you would be perfect, go, sell what you possess and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me." This reply does not do away with the first: following Jesus Christ involves keeping the Commandments. The Law has not been abolished, but rather man is invited to rediscover it in the person of his Master who is its perfect fulfillment. In the three synoptic Gospels, Jesus' call to the rich young man to follow Him, in the obedience of a disciple and in the observance of the Commandments, is joined to the call to poverty and chastity. The evangelical counsels are inseparable from the Commandments.

The gift of the Commandments and of the Law is part of the covenant God sealed with His own. In *Exodus*, the revelation of the "ten words" is granted between the proposal of the covenant and its conclusion - after the people had committed themselves to "do" all that the Lord had said, and to "obey" it. The Decalogue is never handed on without first recalling the covenant ("The LORD our God made a covenant with us in Horeb.").

The Commandments take on their full meaning within the covenant. According to Scripture, man's moral life has all its meaning in and through the covenant. The first of the "ten words" recalls that God loved His people first:

Since there was a passing from the paradise of freedom to the slavery of this world, in punishment for sin, the first phrase of the Decalogue, the first word of God's commandments, bears on freedom "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery."

The Commandments properly so-called come in the second place: they express the implications of belonging to God through the establishment of the covenant. Moral existence is a **response** to the Lord's loving initiative. It is the acknowledgement and homage given to God and a worship of thanksgiving. It is cooperation with the plan God pursues in history.

The covenant and dialogue between God and man are also attested to by the fact that all the obligations are stated in the first person ("I am the Lord.") and addressed by God to another personal subject ("you"). In all God's commandments, the singular personal pronoun designates the recipient.

God makes His will known to each person in particular, at the same time as He makes it known to the whole people:

The Lord prescribed love towards God and taught justice towards neighbor, so that man would be neither unjust, nor unworthy of God. Thus, through the Decalogue, God prepared man to become His friend and to live in harmony with his neighbor.... The words of the Decalogue remain likewise for us Christians. Far from being abolished, they have received amplification and development from the fact of the coming of the Lord in the flesh.

## **THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK**

**Thurs., Oct. 15, St. Teresa of Jesus, Virgin, Doctor.** St. Teresa is the great reformer of the Carmelite Order. Her works of spirituality have merited for her the title of Doctor of the Church. She died in 1582.

**Friday, Oct. 16, St. Marie-Marguerite d'Youville.** On December 31, 1737, St. Marguerite and three companions committed themselves to serve the needy in Montreal. A year later, they began to live together in her house also to take in the destitute. Eventually, they came to be known as the Sisters of Charity of the General Hospital of Montreal. At her beatification in 1959, some 8000 in six autonomous congregations looked to her as foundress.

**Saturday, Oct. 17, St. Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop, Martyr.** St. Ignatius was a successor of St. Peter as Bishop of Antioch. He was martyred in the year 107 by being thrown to wild animals.

“Ascoltino i ricchi, se tuttavia qui ce ne sono; ascoltino l’Apostolo: *Raccomanda ai ricchi di questo mondo - poiché ci sono i ricchi dell’altro mondo: i poveri sono i ricchi dell’altro mondo, i ricchi dell’altro mondo sono gli Apostoli, i quali dicevano: *Rassomigliamo a gente che non ha nulla eppure possiede tutto* (2Cor 6,10). Perché sappiate di quali ricchi egli parla, aggiunge *di questo mondo*. Ascoltino dunque l’Apostolo i ricchi di questo mondo: *Ai ricchi di questo mondo raccomanda di non essere superbi*. Il primo tarlo roditore della ricchezza è la superbia. È un tarlo dannoso, rode ogni cosa e manda tutto in rovina. *Raccomanda quindi loro di non essere superbi e di non riporre la loro speranza nella ricchezza insicura* perché uno, per caso, non si addormenti ricco e si alzi povero. *Raccomanda di non riporre la speranza nelle ricchezze insicure* -sono parole dell’Apostolo- *ma nel Dio vivente*. Il ladro ti potrà portar via l’oro ma chi potrà toglierti Dio? Che cosa ha un ricco, se non ha Dio? Che cosa non ha il povero, se possiede Dio? [Raccomanda di] *non riporre la speranza nella ricchezza ma nel Dio vivente, il quale ci dà tutto in abbondanza, perché ne possiamo godere* (1Tm 6,17), e con tutto il resto dà anche se stesso (Agostino, *Discorso 85, 2-3*).”*

“I discepoli ... mentre erano fiduciosi di salvarsi perché non possedevano ricchezze; allorché si resero conto che non avevano ancora depresso perfettamente le passioni (da poco infatti erano suoi discepoli e da poco erano stati chiamati dal Signore), grandemente si spaventarono e disperarono di se stessi non meno di quel giovane ricchissimo e follemente attaccato ai suoi averi, che appunto preferiva alla vita eterna.(...)
