The name of the Savior God was invoked only once in the year by the high priest in atonement for the sins of Israel, after he had sprinkled the mercy seat in the Holy of Holies with the sacrificial blood. The mercy seat was the place of God's presence. When St. Paul speaks of Jesus whom "God put forward as an expiation by his blood", he means that in Christ's humanity "God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself."

The chosen people was constituted by God as "a kingdom of priests and a holy nation." But within the people of Israel, God chose one of the twelve tribes, that of Levi, and set it apart for liturgical service; God Himself is its inheritance. A special rite consecrated the beginnings of the priesthood of the Old Covenant. The priests are "appointed to act on behalf of men in relation to God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins."

Instituted to proclaim the Word of God and to restore communion with God by sacrifices and prayer, this priesthood nevertheless remains powerless to bring about salvation, needing to repeat its sacrifices ceaselessly and being unable to achieve a definitive sanctification, which only the sacrifice of Christ would accomplish.

The liturgy of the Church, however, sees in the priesthood of Aaron and the service of the Levites, as in the institution of the seventy elders, a prefiguring of the ordained ministry of the New Covenant.

Everything that the priesthood of the Old Covenant prefigured finds its fulfillment in Christ Jesus, the "one mediator between God and men." The Christian tradition considers Melchizedek, "priest of God Most High," as a prefiguration of the priesthood of Christ, the unique "high priest after the order of Melchizedek"; "holy, blameless, unstained," "by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are sanctified," that is, by the unique sacrifice of the cross.

The redemptive sacrifice of Christ is unique, accomplished once for all; yet it is made present in the Eucharistic sacrifice of the Church. The same is true of the one priesthood of Christ; it is made present through the ministerial priesthood without diminishing the uniqueness of Christ's priesthood: "Only Christ is the true priest, the others being only his ministers."

“Amate il Signore! Di più degno di amore non trovate nulla (...). Amate, dico, questa luce, così come amava di un amore immenso colui che faceva giungere a Gesù il suo grido: *Abbi pietà di me, figlio di Davide*. Il cieco gridava così mentre Gesù passava. Temeva che Gesù passasse e non lo risanasse. Con che ardore gridava? Al punto che, mentre la folla lo zittiva, continuava a gridare. La sua voce trionfò su chi lo contrastava e trattenne il Salvatore. Mentre la folla faceva strepito e gli voleva impedire di parlare, Gesù si fermò, lo chiamò e gli disse: *Che vuoi che io faccia per te?* Rispose: *Signore, che io veda*. [E Gesù]: *Vedi! La tua fede ti ha salvato*. Amate Cristo. Desiderate quella luce che è Cristo. Se quel cieco desiderò la luce fisica, quanto più voi dovete desiderare la luce del cuore! A lui eleviamo il nostro grido non tanto con la voce fisica quanto coll’operare rettamente. Cerchiamo di vivere santamente, ridimensioniamo le cose del mondo. Ciò che è effimero sia come nulla per noi. Quando ci comporteremo così, gli uomini mondani ci faranno rimproveri come se ci amassero; uomini mondani che amano la terra, che fanno di polvere, che non traggono nulla dal cielo, che non hanno respiro spirituale ma solo quello delle narici. Ci criticheranno senza dubbio e, vedendoci disprezzare queste cose naturali, queste cose terrene, ci diranno: “Perché vuoi soffrire privazioni? Sei pazzo?”. Costoro sono quella folla che contrastava il cieco quando egli voleva far sentire il suo richiamo. Ci sono alquanti cristiani che contrastano il vivere da cristiani, analogamente a quella folla che camminava con Cristo e tuttavia si opponeva a che ricevesse il beneficio di Cristo quell’uomo che gridava verso di lui e desiderava la luce. Ci sono dei tali cristiani, ma noi cerchiamo di trionfare su di loro e la nostra stessa vita sia come un grido lanciato verso Cristo. (...) Gridiamo dunque e viviamo rettamente (Agostino, *Discorso 349, 5*).”
