**THE SANCTUARY LAMPS THIS WEEK BURN FOR:**

Dear Brothers and Sisters, In this Sunday's Gospel (Lk 14: 1, 7-14), we find Jesus as a guest dining at the house of a Pharisee leader. Noting that the guests were choosing the best places at table, He recounted a parable in the setting of a marriage feast. "When you are invited by anyone to a marriage feast, do not sit down in a place of honour, lest a more eminent man than you be invited by him; and he who invited you both will come, and say to you, 'Give place to this man'.... But when you are invited, go and sit in the lowest place" (Lk 14: 8-10). The Lord does not intend to give a lesson on etiquette or on the hierarchy of the different authorities. Rather, He insists on a crucial point, that of humility: "Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted" (Lk 14: 11). A deeper meaning of this parable also makes us think of the position of the human being in relation to God. The "lowest place" can in fact represent the condition of humanity degraded by sin, a condition from which the Incarnation of the Only-Begotten Son alone can raise it. For this reason Christ Himself "took the lowest place in the world the Cross and by this radical humility He redeemed us and constantly comes to our aid" (Encyclical *Deus Caritas Est*, n. 35).

At the end of the parable Jesus suggests to the Pharisee leader that he invite to his table not his friends, kinsmen or rich neighbours, but rather poorer and more marginalized people who can in no way reciprocate (cf. Lk 14: 13-14), so that the gift may be given freely. The true reward, in fact, will ultimately be given by God, "who governs the world.... We offer Him our service only to the extent that we can, and for as long as He grants us the strength" (Encyclical *Deus Caritas Est*, n. 35). Once again, therefore, let us look to Christ as a model of humility and of giving freely: let us learn from Him patience in temptation, meekness in offence, obedience to God in suffering, in the hope that the One who has invited us will say to us: "Friend, go up higher" (cf. Lk 14: 10). Indeed, the true good is being close to Him. St Louis IX, King of France whose Memorial was last Wednesday put into practice what is written in the Book of Sirach: "The greater you are, the more you must humble yourself; so you will find favour in the sight of the Lord" (3: 18). This is what the King wrote in his "Spiritual Testament to his son": "If the Lord grant you some prosperity, not only must you humbly thank Him but take care not to become worse by boasting or in any other way, make sure, that is, that you do not come into conflict with God or offend Him with His own gifts" (cf. *Acta Sanctorum Augusti* 5 [1868], 546).

Dear friends, today we are also commemorating the Martyrdom of St John the Baptist, the greatest among the prophets of Christ, who was able to deny himself to make room for the Saviour and who suffered and died for the truth. Let us ask him and the Virgin Mary to guide us on the path of humility, in order to become worthy of the divine reward.

**1 settembre 2013 - 22<sup>a</sup> del tempo ordinario**

“Un giorno di sabato, mentre Gesù è a pranzo presso un capo dei farisei, «osservando come gli invitati scelgono i primi posti, dice loro una parabola...». Gesù osserva attentamente gli eventi quotidiani in cui è immerso, traendone preziosi insegnamenti: la sua sapienza, oltre che dalla relazione di fede con il Padre, nasce dalla sua adesione alla realtà; anzi, egli è capace di narrare l'agire di Dio proprio a partire dagli avvenimenti più ordinari, compresi dal suo cuore che sa ascoltare (cf. 1Re 3,9). In questo caso Gesù narra una parabola con cui mette in guardia dal protagonismo di chi cerca i primi posti nei banchetti, rischiando di essere retrocesso all'ultimo posto dal padrone di casa, qualora arrivi un ospite più ragguardevole di lui (cf. Pr 25,6-7). Gesù conosce la smania umana di primeggiare, quella di chi «ama i primi seggi nelle sinagoghe e i primi posti nei banchetti» (Lc 20,46), spesso semplicemente per apparire potente agli occhi altrui. Per questo ammonisce a non presumere di sé, ma a saper restare con obbedienza al proprio posto, quello che Dio assegna a ciascuno di noi. E nel caso si debba scegliere un posto, Gesù chiede di optare per l'ultimo, come ha fatto lui stesso, il Maestro «mite e umile di cuore» (Mt 11,29), il quale «umiliò se stesso facendosi obbediente fino alla morte, anzi alla morte di croce» (Fil 2,8); per questo Dio lo ha esaltato, richiamandolo dalla morte alla vita eterna (cf. Fil 2,9-11). Di seguito Gesù pronuncia un detto divenuto celebre: «Chi si esalta sarà umiliato; chi si umilia sarà esaltato». Di fronte a Dio ogni uomo è posto nella giusta collocazione, e la mano del Signore compie l'esaltazione degli umili e l'abbassamento dei superbi (cf. 1Pt 5,5-6), come canta il Magnificat (cf. Lc 1,46-55). Occorre però ricordare che la cosiddetta «umiltà» è una virtù difficilissima da vivere, sulla quale sarebbe meglio tacere, perché si rischia di ingenerare atteggiamenti perversi, alla ricerca di meriti speciali, finendo per incoraggiare proprio quei comportamenti contestati da Gesù. Meglio sarebbe parlare di «umiliazione», perché solo accogliendo le umiliazioni che ci vengono da noi stessi, dagli altri e da Dio potremo scoprire la nostra radicale povertà e accedere all'umiltà: solo chi accetta le umiliazioni e le assume nella fede è davvero umile! (Enzo Bianchi, priore di Bose).”
