THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, September 12th, Most Holy Name of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This feast honouring the holy name of Mary was instituted by Pope Innocent XI. We call upon her holy name in times of need and out of love for our heavenly mother.

Tuesday, Sept. 13th, St. John Chrysostom, Bishop, Doctor. St. John Chrysostom was elected Bishop of Constantinople in 397 and proved himself a capable pastor, committed to reforming the life of the clergy and the faithful. Twice, he was forced into exile by the hatred of the imperial court and the envy of his enemies. He died on September 14, 407.

Wednesday, September 14th, Exaltation of the Holy Cross. Today's feast commemorates the Veneration of the true Cross & celebrates the double anniversary of the finding of the Cross in Sept. 326 & the dedication of the Churches built by the emperor Constantine on the sites of the Holy Sepulchre and Calvary.

Thursday, Sept. 15th, Our Lady of Sorrows. Today, we commemorate the fidelity of Our Lady at the foot of the Cross and contemplate her compassion.

Friday, Sept. 16th, St. Cornelius, Pope & Martyr, & Cyprian, Bishop & Martyr. Martyrs of the 3rd century who suffered both for the unity of the Church & the Faith.

Saturday, Sept. 17th, St. Robert Bellarmine, Bishop, Doctor.
