THE CROSS IS CHRIST'S GLORY AND TRIUMPH

We are celebrating the feast of the cross which drove away darkness and brought in the light. As we keep this feast, we are lifted up with the crucified Christ, leaving behind us earth and sin so that we may gain the things above. So great and outstanding a possession is the cross that he who wins it has won a treasure. Rightly could I call this treasure the fairest of all fair things and the costliest, in fact as well as in name, for on it and through it and for its sake the riches of salvation that had been lost were restored to us. Had there been no cross, Christ could not have been crucified. Had there been no cross, Life itself could not have been nailed to the tree. And if Life had not been nailed to it, there would be no streams of immortality pouring from Christ's side, blood and water for the world's cleansing. The legal bond of our sin would not be cancelled, we should not have attained our freedom, we should not have enjoyed the fruit of the tree of life and the gates of paradise would not stand open. Had there been no cross, death would not have been trodden underfoot, nor hell despoiled.

Therefore, the cross is something wonderfully great and honourable. It is great because through the cross the many noble acts of Christ found their consummation - very many indeed, for both His miracles and His sufferings were fully rewarded with victory. The cross is honourable because it is both the sign of God's suffering and the trophy of His victory. It stands for His suffering because on it He freely suffered unto death. But it is also His trophy because it was the means by which the devil was wounded and death conquered; the barred gates of hell were smashed, and the cross became the one common salvation of the whole world.

The cross is called Christ's glory; it is saluted as His triumph. We recognise it as the cup He longed to drink and the climax of the sufferings He endured for our sake. As to the cross being Christ's glory, listen to His words: *Now is the Son of Man glorified, and in Him*

God is glorified, and God will glorify Him at once. And again: Father, glorify Me with the glory I had with You before the world came to be. And once more: "Father, glorify Your name." Then a voice came from heaven: "I have glorified it and will glorify it again." Here He speaks of the glory that would accrue to Him through the cross. And if you would understand that the cross is Christ's triumph, hear what He Himself also said: *When I Am lifted up, then I will draw all men to myself.* Now you can see that the cross is Christ's glory and triumph.

Esaltazione della Santa Croce – 14 settembre 2014

“Che nessuno, dunque, si vergogni dei segni sacri e venerabili della nostra salvezza, della Croce che è la somma e il vertice dei nostri beni, per la quale noi viviamo e siamo ciò che siamo. Portiamo ovunque la Croce di Cristo, come una corona. Tutto ciò che ci riguarda si compie e si consuma attraverso di essa. Quando noi dobbiamo essere rigenerati dal battesimo, la Croce è presente; se ci alimentiamo di quel mistico cibo che è il corpo di Cristo, se ci vengono imposte le mani per essere consacrati ministri del Signore, e qualsiasi altra cosa facciamo, sempre e ovunque ci sta accanto e ci assiste questo simbolo di vittoria. Di qui il fervore con cui noi lo conserviamo nelle nostre case, lo dipingiamo sulle nostre pareti, lo incidiamo sulle porte, lo imprimiamo sulla nostra fronte e nella nostra mente, lo portiamo sempre nel cuore. La Croce è infatti il segno della nostra salvezza e della comune libertà del genere umano, è il segno della misericordia del Signore che per amor nostro si è lasciato condurre come pecora al macello. Quando, dunque, ti fai questo segno, ricorda tutto il mistero della Croce e spegni in te l'ira e tutte le altre passioni. E ancora, quando ti segni in fronte, riempiti di grande ardimento e ridà alla tua anima la sua libertà. Conosci bene infatti quali sono i mezzi che ci procurano la libertà. Anche Paolo per elevarci alla libertà che ci conviene ricorda la Croce e il sangue del Signore: A caro prezzo siete stati comprati. Non fatevi schiavi degli uomini (1Co 7,23). Considerate, egli sembra dire, quale prezzo è stato pagato per il vostro riscatto e non sarete più schiavi di nessun uomo; e chiama la Croce «prezzo» del riscatto. Non devi quindi tracciare semplicemente il segno della Croce con la punta delle dita, ma prima devi incidere nel tuo cuore con fede ardente. Se lo imprimerai in questo modo sulla tua fronte, nessuno dei demoni impuri potrà restare accanto a te, in quanto vedrà l'arma con cui è stato ferito, la spada da cui ha ricevuto il colpo mortale. Se la sola vista del luogo dove avviene l'esecuzione dei criminali fa fremere d'orrore, immagina che cosa proveranno il diavolo e i suoi demoni vedendo l'arma con cui Cristo sgominò completamente il loro potere e tagliò la testa del dragone. Non vergognarti, dunque, di così grande bene se non vuoi che anche Cristo si vergogni di te quando verrà nella sua gloria e il segno della Croce apparirà più luminoso dei raggi stessi del sole. La Croce avanzerà allora e il suo apparire sarà come una voce che difenderà la causa del Signore di fronte a tutti gli uomini e dimostrerà che nulla egli tralasciò di fare - di quanto era necessario da parte sua - per assicurare la nostra salvezza. Questo segno, sia ai tempi dei nostri padri come oggi, apre le porte che erano chiuse, neutralizza l'effetto mortale dei veleni, annulla il potere letale della cicuta, cura i morsi dei serpenti velenosi. Infatti, se questa Croce ha dischiuso le porte dell'oltretomba, ha disteso nuovamente le volte del cielo, ha rinnovato l'ingresso del paradiso, ha distrutto il dominio del diavolo, c'è da stupirsi se essa ha anche vinto la forza dei veleni, delle belve e di altri simili mortali pericoli? Imprimi, dunque, questo segno nel tuo cuore e abbraccia questa Croce, cui dobbiamo la salvezza delle nostre anime. È la Croce infatti che ha salvato e convertito tutto il mondo, ha bandito l'errore, ha ristabilito la verità, ha fatto della terra cielo, e degli uomini angeli. Grazie a lei i demoni hanno cessato di essere temibili e sono divenuti disprezzabili; la morte non è più morte, ma sonno. Per la Croce tutto quanto combatteva contro di noi giace a terra e viene calpestato.

Se pertanto qualcuno ti chiedesse: Tu adori colui che è stato crocifisso? rispondigli con voce chiara e con volto gioioso: Sì, io l'adoro, e non cesserò mai di adorarlo. E se quello ride di te, tu compiangilo perché è stolto.

Rendiamo grazie al Signore che ci ha concesso doni così straordinari che nessuno potrebbe comprendere senza la rivelazione dall'alto. Quel tale infatti si prende gioco di voi, perché l'uomo animale non percepisce le cose dello Spirito (1Co 2,14) (S. Giovanni Crisostomo, In Matth., 54, 4-5)."
