‘If anyone wants to be first, he must make himself last of all and servant of all.’

Jesus uses this argument going on behind His back to teach His disciples about how authority should be exercised in His Church – not by lording it over others, but by serving them. In fulfilling His own mission to found the Church whose head and supreme lawgiver He is, He came to serve and not to be served (Mt. 20:28).

Anyone who does not strive to have this attitude of self-forgetful service not only lacks one of the main pre-requisites for proper exercise of authority but also runs the risk of being motivated by ambition or pride. “To be in charge of an apostolic undertaking demands readiness to suffer everything, from everybody, with infinite charity” (J. Escriva, *The Way*, 951).

To demonstrate to His Apostles the abnegation and humility needed in their ministry, he takes a child into His arms and explains the meaning of this gesture: if we receive for Christ’s sake those who have little importance in the world’s eyes, it is as if we are embracing Christ Himself and the Father who sent Him. This little child whom Jesus embraces represents every child in the world, and everyone who is needy, helpless, poor or sick....

St. John Vianney who will be declared the universal patron of all priests at the end of this year, led a deeply spiritual life which may serve as a model not only for priests but for all the faithful. The solid foundation of his spiritual life was the Sacred Liturgy of the Church. Below is a list of the Recollection topics. The Recollections will end at noon with the recitation of the Angelus.

- Sat., Nov. 7th- *Atonement, Reconciliation & Penance*
- Sat., December 5th - *The Sacred Liturgy*

THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, September 21st, St. Matthew, Apostle, Evangelist. The account of Matthew’s conversion from a life of sin as a publican contains the invitation that Jesus wishes to each of His followers: “Follow Me.” His gospel, considered the first to have been written, was the favourite Gospel of the early Church.

Tuesday, September 23rd, St. Pio of Pietrelcina, Priest. Padre Pio was born Francesco Forgione in Pietrelcina, Italy on May 25 1887. At a very young age, he dedicated his life to God. He was ordained in the year 1910 and lived most of his life as a Capuchin friar in San Giovanni Rotondo. He became famous for his piety and for the visible wounds of Christ on his body. He died in 1968.

Saturday, September 26th, St. Jean de Brebeuf and St. Isaac Jogues, Priests, and Companions, Martyrs. St. Isaac Jogues and Companions were the first North American martyrs officially recognized by the Church. They suffered greatly for the Church and the Faith in the 1600’s.

"Tutta la pratica della sapienza cristiana non consiste né in abbondanza di parole, né in abilità nel discutere, né in appetiti di lode e di gloria, bensì nella sincera e volontaria umiltà che il Signore Gesù Cristo ha scelto e insegnato con ogni mezzo, dal seno materno fino al supplizio della croce. Cristo ama l'infanzia e verso di lei orienta il modo di agire degli adulti; verso di lei riconduce gli anziani; egli attrae al suo esempio personale coloro che egli innalza al regno eterno. Se però vogliamo divenire capaci di capire come sia possibile pervenire ad una conversione così mirabile, e per quali trasformazioni si debba ritornare allo stato d'infanzia, lasciamo che sia san Paolo a istruirci, con le parole: *Non siate come bambini nel modo di giudicare, siate invece bambini in fatto di malizia* (1 Cor 14,20). Non si tratta perciò di tornare alle goffaggini degli inizi, bensì di riprendere da essa una cosa che si addice benissimo anche agli anni della maturità, cioè che svaniscano senza indugi le nostre agitazioni interiori e che ritroviamo rapidamente la pace; che non serbiamo ricordo delle offese; che non siamo minimamente avidi di dignità; che amiamo stare insieme serbandone un'uguaglianza secondo natura (Leone Magno, *Sermone VII*)."

"Quello indicato da Gesù attraverso la figura del bambino, è il primato del servizio. Per servire e per entrare nel regno, è chiesto di diventare piccoli come bimbi: *se non vi convertirete e non diventerete come fanciulli non entrerete nel regno dei cieli* (Mt 18,3). Accanto a questo vi è però un altro possibile senso (particolarmente comprensibile per noi moderni): chi si trova nella condizione di aver diritto di essere servito (il bambino), è chiamato invece a servire. Il bimbo nel vangelo è simbolo del rovesciamento di chi da grande si fa piccolo, di chi, pur trovandosi nella posizione di essere servito, vuole invece servire. La presenza di Dio nel mondo è legata a questo rovesciamento. Ecco perché è richiesto di riconoscere nel servo e nel bambino la presenza di chi invia (Mc 9, 37). (...) Il primo e il più grande servitore nel suo farsi piccolo è Gesù stesso, il quale (come dice un frammento dell'apocrifo e perduto 'Vangelo dei Nazirei') "ha baciato i piedi a ognuno" (P. Stefani, *Sia santificato il tuo nome B*, 175-6)."
