HELL

We cannot be united with God unless we freely choose to love Him. But we cannot love God if we sin gravely against Him, against our neighbor or against ourselves: "He who does not love remains in death. Anyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him." Our Lord warns us that we shall be separated from Him if we fail to meet the serious needs of the poor and the little ones who are His brethren. To die in mortal sin without repenting and accepting God's merciful love means remaining separated from Him forever **by our own free choice**. This state of definitive self-exclusion from communion with God and the blessed is called "hell."

Jesus often speaks of "Gehenna" of "the unquenchable fire" reserved for those who to the end of their lives refuse to believe and be converted, where both soul and body can be lost. Jesus solemnly proclaims that He "will send His angels, and they will gather... all evil doers, and throw them into the furnace of fire," and that He will pronounce the condemnation: "Depart from Me, you cursed, into the eternal fire!"

The teaching of the Church affirms the existence of hell and its eternity. Immediately after death the souls of those who die in a state of mortal sin descend into hell, where they suffer the punishments of hell, "eternal fire." The chief punishment of hell is eternal separation from God, in Whom alone man can possess the life and happiness for which he was created and for which he longs.

The affirmations of Sacred Scripture and the teachings of the Church on the subject of hell are a call to the responsibility incumbent upon man to make use of his freedom in view of his eternal destiny. They are at the same time an urgent call to conversion: "Enter by the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is easy, that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard, that leads to life, and those who find it are few."

Since we know neither the day nor the hour, we should follow the advice of the Lord and watch constantly so that, when the single course of our earthly life is completed, we may merit to enter with him into the marriage feast and be numbered among the blessed, and not, like the wicked and slothful servants, be ordered to depart into the eternal fire, into the outer darkness where "men will weep and gnash their teeth."

God predestines no one to go to hell; for this, a willful turning away from God (a mortal sin) is necessary, and persistence in it until the end. In the Eucharistic liturgy and in the daily prayers of her faithful, the Church implores the mercy of God, Who does not want "any to perish, but all to come to repentance":

Father, accept this offering from your whole family. Grant us Your peace in this life, save us from final damnation, and count us among those You have chosen.

Tuesday, September 29th, St. Michael, St. Gabriel, and St. Raphael, Archangels. We celebrate the ministry of these angels to whom God has entrusted particular tasks in the Mystery of Salvation.

Wednesday, Sept. 30, Dedication of St. Michael's Cathedral. Today in the Archdiocese of Toronto, we celebrate the Feast of the dedication of our Cathedral. St. Jerome's mastery of languages enabled him to translate the Bible into Latin, the language of the common people. This translation is considered an official text of the Catholic Church. He died in the year 420.

Thursday, Oct. 1, St. Therese of the Child Jesus, Virgin, Doctor. St. Therese was born at Alencon, France in 1873. She entered the Carmelite Monastery in Lisieux at the age of 15. There she lived a life of evangelical simplicity, humility and trust in God. Her autobiography, *Story of a Soul* is a spiritual classic.

Friday, Oct. 2, Guardian Angels. The word angel means messenger. Angels are God's messengers assigned to help us while always remaining in the presence of God (cf. Matt 18:10).

“Se il tuo occhio, la tua mano e il tuo piede ti scandalizzano - come hai sentito nel Vangelo- *tagliali e gettali via*. Chiunque ti è caro, chiunque è assai stimato da te, tienilo per grande, tienilo come tuo membro amato fino a quando non comincerà a scandalizzarti, cioè a spingerti a commettere qualche male. State a sentire: questo è lo scandalo. ...Ascolta il Vangelo: quando il Signore parlò agli Apostoli della sua imminente passione, Pietro prese ad esortarlo ad evitarla, ma il Signore: *Va' indietro, Satana -gli rispose- tu mi sei di scandalo* (Mt 16,23). In una parola, il Signore, che ti ha dato l'esempio di come vivere, non solo ti ha insegnato che cos'è lo scandalo ma anche in qual modo si deve evitarlo. Poco prima aveva detto a Pietro: *Beato sei tu Simone, figlio di Giovanni*, mostrando così ch'era suo membro. Ma quando cominciò ad essere di scandalo, Cristo tagliò quel membro. Poi lo fece tornare come prima e lo ristabilì come suo membro. Sarà dunque per te uno scandalo chi prende l'iniziativa di persuaderti a fare qualcosa di male... Che farai? È un occhio, è una mano. *Tagliali e gettali lontano da te*. Che vuol dire: *Tagliali e gettali lontano da te?* Non dargli retta. Questo significa... In effetti le nostre membra formano un'unità; vivono, sono legate insieme nel nostro corpo in virtù del loro accordo. Dov'è il disaccordo, lì c'è morte o ferita. È dunque un tuo membro: devi amarlo. Ma se ti scandalizza, *Taglialo e gettalo via da te*. Non dargli retta, allontanalo dalle tue orecchie, forse tornerà corretto (Agostino, dal *Discorso 81, 4*).”
