*Dear Brothers and Sisters,*

The biblical Readings of Mass this Sunday converge on the theme of brotherly love in the community of believers whose source lies in the communion of the Trinity. The Apostle Paul says that the whole Law of God finds fullness in love, so that in our relationships with others the Ten Commandments and every other precept are summed up in these words: "Love your neighbour as yourself" (cf. Rom 13:8-10). The Gospel text from chapter 18 of Matthew on the life of the Christian community tells us that brotherly love also involves a sense of mutual responsibility. For this reason if my brother commits a sin against me I must treat him charitably and first of all, speak to him privately, pointing out that what he has said or done is wrong. This approach is known as "fraternal correction": it is not a reaction to the offence suffered but is motivated by love for one's brethren.

St Augustine comments: "Whoever has offended you, in offending you, has inflicted a serious injury upon himself; and would you not care for a brother's injury?... You must forget the offence you have

received but not the injury of one of your brethren (*Discourse 82, 7*). And what if my brother does not listen to me? In today's Gospel Jesus points to a gradual approach: first, speak to him again with two or three others, the better to help him realize what he has done; if, in spite of this, he still refuses to listen, it is necessary to tell the community; and if he refuses to listen even to the community, he must be made to perceive that he has cut himself off by separating himself from the communion of the Church.

All this demonstrates that we are responsible for each other in the journey of Christian life; each person, aware of his own limitations and shortcomings, is called to accept fraternal correction and to help others with this specific service.

Another fruit of love in the community is unanimous prayer. Jesus said: "If two of you agree on earth about anything they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in Heaven. For where two or three are gathered in My name, there Am I in the midst of them" (Mt 18:19-20). Personal prayer is of course important, indeed indispensable, but the Lord guarantees His presence to the community — even if it is very small — which is united and in agreement, because this reflects the very reality of the Triune God, perfect communion of love. Origen says "we should practise this symphony" (*Commentary on the Gospel according to Matthew, 14,1*), in other words this harmony within the Christian community. We should practise both fraternal correction — which demands deep humility and simplicity of heart — and prayer so that it may rise to God from a community truly united in Christ.

Let us ask all this through the intercession of Mary Most Holy, Mother of the Church ....

**THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK**

**Monday, September 8<sup>th</sup>, Birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary.** This feast celebrates the birth of Our Lady, the dawn announcing the coming of God's Son into the world.

**Tuesday, September 9<sup>th</sup>, St. Peter Claver, Priest.** St. Peter Claver was born in Spain in 1580 and joined the Society of Jesus in 1600. He was sent to Cartagena in South America, then the centre of the slave trade. For nearly forty years, he ministered tirelessly to the slaves and pleaded for their humane treatment. He died in 1654 and was canonized in 1888.

**Friday, September 12<sup>th</sup>, Most Holy Name of the Blessed Virgin Mary.** This feast honouring the holy name of Mary was instituted by Pope Innocent XI. We call upon her holy name in times of need and out of love for our heavenly mother.

**Saturday, Sept. 13<sup>th</sup>, St. John Chrysostom, Bishop, Doctor.** St. John Chrysostom was elected Bishop of Constantinople in 397 and proved himself a capable pastor, committed to reforming the life of the clergy and the faithful. Twice, he was forced into exile by the hatred of the imperial court and the envy of his enemies. He died on September 14, 407.

Non dovremmo dunque allontanare ogni nostro scoraggiamento e riempirci di letizia? Non solo per il numero delle persone che vi si radunano la riunione in chiesa è migliore degli incontri sulla piazza, ma anche per gli argomenti che vi si trattano. Anzi, c'è l'abitudine di indagare e investigare con gran cura gli affari degli altri. Parliamo della nostra anima e dei beni che interessano l'anima, della corona che c'è riposta nel cielo, della rettitudine nella vita, della bontà di Dio, e della sua provvidenza per tutto il mondo e ancora di tutte le cose che ci riguardano, il motivo per cui siamo stati creati e la sorte che ci aspettiamo quando ce ne partiamo da quaggiù, e la situazione che verrà per noi decisa. A queste riunioni non solo noi prendiamo parte, ma anche i profeti e gli apostoli; anzi, il fatto più grande è che il Signore di noi tutti, Gesù, sta in mezzo a noi.
