Quando Gesù sospira profondamente, mette al servizio della guarigione altrui tutto il soffio della propria conversione. Questo Spirito non smette di catturare tutti i nostri sensi nel Battesimo, e lo Spirito ripropone i gesti del Cristo per significare questa appartenenza, sulle nostre labbra, sulle nostre orecchie, sui nostri occhi... (Père Christian de Chergé: “Dieu pour tout jour”. Editions de Bellefontaine - 1 agosto 1986: conversione di tutto l’essere).”
