

The Lord's Baptism- Our Baptism

In today's feast we celebrate the baptism of Jesus by John in the waters of the Jordan. *"The Lord desired to be baptised,* says St. Augustine, so that He might freely proclaim through His humility what for us was to be a necessity. St. Augustine, Sermon 51, 33

In baptism we receive faith and grace. Today our prayer enables us to thank God for this and to rejoice in the countless good things He has so lavishly bestowed on us. Thanksgiving is the very first emotion that should be born in us in response to our baptism: the second is joy. Never should we think of our baptism without deep feelings of interior gladness.
