MASS MINUTES

Liturgy of the Eucharist-Preparation of the Gifts

The Liturgy of the Eucharist takes place at the Altar where the priest, acting as Christ Himself (in persona Christi) makes present the Last Supper and the Passion and the death of our Lord on the cross. As in the Last Supper, the priest uses the bread and wine, which become the Body and Blood of Christ. Members of the faithful carry the offerings to the priest standing at the foot of the Sanctuary. This action has symbolic significance and recalls the thanksgiving sacrifices of the Old Testament which were in the form of bread and wine. By the presentation of the offerings, the faithful demonstrate their thankfulness to Christ for having saved them from eternal death because of their sins, just as the Old Testament patriarchs expressed their thankfulness for preservation from physical death by offerings of bread and wine. The chalice is placed on the altar at this time and is unveiled (the chalice veil color follows the liturgical season line the vestments of the priest and the altar). The act of removing the chalice veil symbolizes the stripping from Christ of His garments before He was nailed to the cross. After the initial prayers of offering over the bread and wine by the priest, he may incense them as well as "the cross and the altar itself, so as to signify the Church's offering and prayer rising like incense in the sight of God. Next, the priest, because of his sacred ministry, and the people, by the reason of their baptismal dignity may be incensed". After the incensing, the servers wash their priest's hands while the priest prays for the purification from his sinfulness. The exterior cleaning signifies the desired interior purification. The priest desires to be as worthy as possible, in order for Christ to work through him.
