AROUND THE ALTAR OF THE LORD The Concluding Rite – The Dismissal



The dismissal at the end of the Mass is more than a mere indication that Mass is over and the congregation may disperse. The words generally used when and where the Mass is

offered in English are, "Go in the peace of Christ," to which the congregation replies, "Thanks be to God". The faithful do not merely go. They are sent. The aspect of sending comes out more clearly in the Latin text of Mass of which the English is a translation. The Latin text reads "Ite missa est," which, translated more literally than the offical English version, means "Go She (the Church) has been sent." The official English translation points out well that the Church is sent with the peace of Christ. Strengthened by the sacrament that they have received, the faithful are to bring Christ's peace out into the world. And by their presence in the world, the faithful as "the light of the world" (Matt 5:14) are to bring the world into the Church so that all may be gathered to the Lord and receive the redemption brought about by the cross and participate in the feast of the Lamb of God.




