

#### AROUND THE ALTAR OF THE LORD



#### The Beginning of the Mass – The Entrance

The Mass begins with the chanting or singing appropriate to the liturgical season intended to raise the minds of the faithful to the mysteries that they are about to celebrate (GIRM 28). At the same time,

there is the procession to the altar of the priest (and deacon) led by the servers. The thurifer (incense carrier) leads the procession followed by the crucifer (cross-bearer) and then by the candle bearers. The fragrant burning of incense in liturgical worship and as a sign of reverence is an ancient practice that precedes even the birth of Christ, and incense (frankincense) was one of gifts presented to Christ by the Three Kings. The smoke arising from the censor (thurible) symbolizes the prayers of the Church. Like the smoke of the incense that rises and makes a beautiful fragrance, the prayers of the Church rise up to God and are pleasing to Him. The candles in the procession, like the candles on or near the altar, serve as reminders that Christ is the light of the world. Moreover, like the candles follow the cross in the procession to the altar, those who follow Christ have received the light of His truth. Other altar servers who not only serve but represent Christ at the altar, lectors and ministers of communion who also minister to God's people the good gifts of the Lord complete the procession. On reaching the altar, the priest first kisses it and then proceeds to incense the altar walking around the altar as he does so. At this time the priest will also incense the crucifix that is on or near the altar, three times raising the incense and each time swinging twice. Once the priest has incensed all around the altar, he will proceed to his chair completing the procession.

#### LET A CHILD HAVE FAITH IN YOU

Each year in the Catholic community, there are hundreds of children that need to leave their family home and be placed in foster care. At any given time, there are more than 1,100 children and youth unable to live with their parents due to parental illness, abandonment, child abuse or neglect. The Catholic Children's Aid Society of Toronto depends on loving foster families to provide safe and nurturing homes for these vulnerable children and youth.

Sadly, there are not enough foster homes to accommodate these children in the Greater Toronto area. In the words of Archbishop Thomas Collins: "I strongly believe that more Catholic families would be open to caring for foster children if they were aware of this urgent need for foster homes. I am inviting you to seriously consider fostering, and reflect on the benefit the experience can bring to your family and vulnerable children in the community."


