

AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE


As you know, earlier in the summer I mentioned some immediate maintenance issues. We have iterated some concerns in the letter that was mailed to all registered Parishioners the week of Sept 5th. We included here in case you did not receive the letter, (if you are a registered parishioner and did not receive the letter, please check with the office to make sure we have your correct mailing address.) Please note that the envelope mentioned can also be found at the back of the Church for your convenience. The letter reads thusly:

My Dear Parishioners:

I would like to bring you up to date on two major renovation issues that the Church has. The parish hall furnace and the Church roof.

We have received several complaints in the winter time that the Hall is very cold. That is because we need a new furnace. We have a debt to pay our mortgage and you, our parishioners have been very generous in helping us make our regularly scheduled payments, and to pay off the principal. However, if we use this money to buy a new furnace, it would be a betrayal of trust and I do not believe to do so. To be transparent and honest, we are humbly asking for a one time donation from every family to give a minimum donation of \$100.00. If you are in a position to give more, we would be forever grateful for your generosity. We would like to have this work completed by October this year before winter sets in and so we have provided a special envelope which is enclosed with this letter and can be dropped off at the parish office or in our weekend collections.

Also we have had a water leak in the Sacristy to repair. In July we were informed that our roof is facing major issues. A larger issue than the furnace, we need to come together and decide what should be done as again we will have recourse for your generosity. But I believe that something of this magnitude needs to be discussed as a community. Our new roofer - Josh Ninabel from Forever Green Roofing Inc. will be available to come to our meeting and discuss what we need to do and can present us with several options. The look of the parish roof that many have come to love will require a decision reached together. Please come to the Town Hall Roof Meeting on Tuesday, September 27th at 7:00pm. We need your input.
