**THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK**

**Tuesday Aug 29, *The Passion of St. John the Baptist***, Besides our Lord and our Lady, *St. John the Baptist* is the only one whose birth and death are celebrated. His father Zechariah spoke the *Benedictus*, Isaiah's prophecy that there would be one who would prepare the way of the Lord. In the wilderness "the word of God came to him," and he began preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. He blamed Herod to his face for the scandal of his illegal union with his sister-in-law Herodias, whose husband was still alive. This led to his imprisonment and beheading.

**Saturday Sept 3<sup>rd</sup>. *St. Gregory the Great*** was Pope between 590 and 604 and is known for strengthening respect for doctrine - "Gregorian" chant draws its name from him. He reformed the clergy and the liturgy, emptied the papal treasury to ransom prisoners of the Lombards and to care for persecuted Jews and the victims of plague and famine and sent his monks to work for the conversion of England. "It is impossible to conceive what would have been the confusion, the lawlessness, the chaotic state of the Middle Ages without the medieval papacy; and of the medieval papacy, the real father is Gregory the Great."

**A GOOD HABIT THAT REALLY MAKES A DIFFERENCE**

In response to the discord and troubles around us, in our country and in our world, we need to go back to the fundamental teaching of Jesus Christ and the teaching of the Catholic Church: to trust in God. Simply, it means believing that God loves us, that He is good and that He has the power to help us, and wants to help us; and He will help us. As Christians, we are more like unbelieving believers -- we trust our friends, the media, or the government, more than we trust God and His Word.

In John 15:5, Jesus says that apart from Him, we can do nothing. We need to lean on Him for help with everything in our lives. We go to church, hear God's message on what we should do and then we go home and try to do it alone. We end up fearful, anxious, worried and telling God how hard we are trying or asking, why is this happening? We are missing the essential point -- we are leaving Him out!

God wants us to put Him first in our lives. He wants us to put our confidence and trust in Him, all the time and in everything. In Proverbs 3:5-6, it is written: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths."

As we return from summer vacations, let us try to really spend some time reading, meditating on and actively listening to, Scripture and to hear God speaking to our hearts -- wherein He dwells -- and then we can make decisions based on what He is leading us to do, not just on what we may think, feel or want. There are many opportunities available to us: attending Mass, weekly bible study programs, parish ministries, our online gift subscription for parishioners to FORMED.org.

It is never too late to make a fresh start with God. He is waiting for us to open the door to Him. Life can be simple and peaceful when we approach Him like the little children, "God, when I don't know what to do, I'll trust in You, when I don't understand why, I'll trust it to You. I'll do my part with Your help, and when I can do no more, I'll trust You to do the rest.
