FEAST OF THE WEEK ST. STEPHEN

St. Basil the Great was a man of vast learning, eloquence and charity. First was a lawyer then a monk, Basil was one of the giants of the early Church. After studying various modes of religious life, he founded what was probably the first monastery in Asia Minor. He is to monks of the East what Saint Benedict is to the West, and Basil's principles influence Eastern monasticism today.

St Gregory of Nazianzen joined St. Basil's new monastery and as a priest he skillfully avoided a schism due to Arianism. At 41, Gregory was chosen suffragan bishop of Caesarea and like his good friend St. Basil, had a hard time opposing the then-Arian emperor, Valens, who supported the Arians. After the death of Valens, Gregory was called to rebuild the faith in the great See of Constantinople, which had been under Arian teachers for three decades. He is famous for his great sermons on the Trinity. In time, Gregory did rebuild the faith in the city, but at the cost of great suffering, slander, insults and even personal violence.

The Holy Family

The feast of the Holy Family fittingly takes the place of the Sunday in the Octave of Christmas.

The Entrance Antiphon recalls that God the Son, in becoming man, makes His home on earth. He takes to Himself the natural human loyalty and affection of a family, and gives obedience and devotion to His human parents. We are reminded that the Family is the "Church in the Home", in which we first learn the ways of the Faith: our prayers and the richness of loving human relationships.

The Family bond reflects in a way the life of the Blessed Trinity as a communion of Persons bound together in an unbreakable unity of love. In His family, Our Lord learnt love and self-sacrifice, the very qualities that prepared Him for His Public Ministry and the Work of our Redemption. ~ Fr Paul Dobson
