

#### NEW YEAR'S MESSAGE FROM FR. NEIMAN D'SOUZA

As 2017 comes to a close, I am sure there are many reasons we give thanks to God as well as many things we wish had turned out differently this past year. For instance, it is a special treat to have a seminarian intern, Joshua Lobo, assigned here at the parish. I am sure that many of us enjoy his joyful spirit and thoughtful reflections. At the same time, I know there are a minority of parishioners who are concerned with growing number of staff members with beards. Scripture provides little comfort for those who stumble over stubble: "You shall not round off the hair on you temples or mar the edges of your beard." (Leviticus 19:27 RSV)

This past year we concluded the celebration of the 150th anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima. Our Lady cares deeply for her Son, Jesus Christ, and therefore also for the Church, which is His Body. For the Solemnity of Holy Mary, Mother of God, perhaps we may consider being more sensitive this year to the maternal role of Our Lady in the Church and our maternal role as a Church. A particular joy is the welcoming and care of young families and children in our parish. Apart from intercessory prayer for young people and families, which is certainly important, perhaps we might also consider volunteering to assist with the sacramental preparation for First Communion and Confirmation. Another consideration would be to make a special effort at masses to greet and interact with young families at Church. Sometimes it is hard to bring the little ones to Jesus. These precious treasures make noises regardless of the length and quality of the homily. Perhaps this year, with more compassion and joy, in union with Mary, we may be inspired to do more to care for children, so that with Jesus, they may increase "in wisdom and in stature, and in favor with God and man." (Luke 2:52 RSV).
