THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Thursday, February 5 <u>St. Agatha, Martyr</u>, is one of seven women, who, along with the Blessed Virgin Mary, are commemorated by name in the Canon of the Mass. According to legend she was from a rich and noble family who dedicated herself to God and rejected the amorous advances of the lowborn Roman prefect Quinitianus. To dissuade her, he sent her to a brothel then a prison and when she would not acquiesce, had her tortured. She died in prison (ca. 251) while awaiting execution.

Friday, February 6 <u>St. Paul Miki & Companions, Martyrs.</u> St. Paul was the son of a Japanese military leader who joined the Jesuits and became known for his eloquent preaching. He and 25 other Catholics (that included Jesuit and Franciscan religious) were crucified on a hill near Nagasaki in 1597 during the persecution of Christians under the Taiko, Toyotomi Hideyoshi, ruler of Japan, in the name of the emperor.
