The Season of LENT

Lent is the yearly celebration by the Church of its corporate conversion in Jesus Christ. It prepares the faithful for Easter as they recall their baptism and do penance in preparation for the greatest feast of the year. Lent has two major purposes: It recalls or prepares for baptism, and emphasizes a spirit of penance. Through forty days of closer attention to God's word and of more fervent prayer, believers are prepared to celebrate the paschal mystery. During Lent, it is especially important to remember the social consequences of sin as well as the fact that the heart of the virtue of penance is hatred of sin as an offence against God. Let us pray and do penance not just for ourselves but for all sinners.

LENTEN FASTING & ABSTINENCE

In preparation for the Solemn Feast of Easter, the faithful do penance through fasting, almsgiving, prayers, works of mercy and abstinence from meat. All Fridays are days of abstinence from meat, but in Canada, Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. The law of abstinence binds those who are 14 years of age and up. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are mandatory days of fasting. On fast days Church discipline permits one to take a main and two lesser meatless meals which do not equal the main meal. The law of fasting binds those from 18 - 59 years of age. Collections will go to support our Seminarians **

A FREE AND HEALTHY SOCIETY CANNOT EXIST UNDER A STATE-IMPOSED IDEOLOGY

As we write to our Members of Parliament about the Summer Job Program issue in support of Cardinal Collins and other faith leaders, we will, no doubt, receive a response from their offices that implies that we have received 'misleading information'. The response seems to diminish the importance of the attestation where many feel that they are compromising their beliefs and conscience by signing it.

In essence, the government is asking groups to recognize that both the job and the core mandate of the organization respects individual human rights. In fact it explicitly mentions rights that are not found in the Charter.

It might be useful to see what the attestation says:

"I attest that the job and my organization's core mandate respect individual human rights in Canada, including the values underlying the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms as well as other rights. These include reproductive rights and the right to be free from discrimination on the basis of sex, religion, race, national or ethnic origin, colour, mental or physical disability or sexual orientation, or gender identity or expression."

(current wording found on the Application for summer job grants).

There are several problems with this attestation. Some of it is vague. What are the values that underlie the Charter and who defines them? What process is to be used to define them? They also impose values on us that we do not believe; we do not recognize abortion (which is hidden under the deceptive expression "reproductive rights") as a value. It is not the place of governments to define what we believe or hold as values.

As stated by Cardinal Collins, we are not able to sign such an attestation because a portion of that declaration goes against our beliefs and infringes upon our freedom of conscience and religion. That some elected officials fail to understand this is profoundly troubling. Rather than addressing legitimate concerns, such responses contribute to confusing the issue by accusing those who have objections to the government's course of action of sharing misleading information. We are hoping that our elected officials are capable of engaging in real dialogue with us rather than using well scripted and choreographed responses and events to which we have become accustomed in the past few years.

I thank all who have already written to their MP's and invite all of us to pray that the rights of each of us to freedom of conscience and religion be respected.
