#### A CHRISTIAN IDEA OF JUSTICE

So many phrases have come from the Bible and Shakespeare: "An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth" from today's Gospel is a good example; to "get his pound of flesh" from Shakespeare's "Merchant of Venice" is another. One of the themes of that great (and controversial) play is precisely the theme of today's Gospel, the contrast between justice and mercy, the letter of the law and its spirit. Shylock, the Jewish merchant eager for his pound of flesh, wants the judge to follow <sup>1a</sup> the law to the letter: "an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth" he might have said. But Portia, the Christian judge says in her great speech that, "the quality of mercy is not strained. It droppeth as the gentle rain from heaven upon the place beneath. It is twice blest: it blesseth him that gives and him that takes." It may not be quite fair to make this issue a difference between a Jewish and a Christian idea of justice. But it is precisely at this moment in the Gospel that our Lord initiates a change between an Old Testament and a New Testament understanding of law. The old justice of Old Testament times, the "eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth" view, was not all bad. It prevented feuds from escalating out of control, each side committing worse and worse atrocities in the name of revenge.

The Chosen People were certainly the light of the world and the salt of the earth to the nations around them on account of this strictly fair view of justice. But in today's Gospel, our Lord is giving to the world a new justice, one that looks mad: "offer the n wicked man no resistance". But it is not madness. In the world of our Lord's time, to be hit on the cheek was not just violence but a calculated insult. To offer the other cheek was to rise above the insult and show yourself equal to the one who had insulted you. To hit back just perpetuated evil; to turn the other cheek was not just "non-violent" but a way of shaming the other person into seeing the folly of their own violence. In a world where most poor people possessed only two garments, their tunic and their cloak, to offer the cloak to one who had taken the tunic was to go naked. Again, the poor man's nakedness is not good for its own sake; but it speaks volumes when it makes the rich man's wealth look shaming by contrast. Our Lord's new justice shames those who commit wicked deeds not by letting them "just get away with it" but by confronting them with God's generosity.

We should always try to be more generous than those who wish us harm, not to ignore justice but simply to end the cycle of evil and to shame them into an imitation of God's generosity as it is reflected in our lives.


