#### 2<sup>ND</sup> CORPORAL WORK OF MERCY TO GIVE DRINK TO THE THIRSTY

In the mind of the early Church, to give drink to the thirsty most certainly would have been connected with the gift of living water as preached in the Gospel. In Rome or most of the urbanized areas, one would have been hardpressed to find bodies dying of thirst. But one could find a plentiful supply of souls hungering and thirsting after righteousness.

We suffer from a thirst that no earthly water can satisfy so to give drink to the thirsty is now, as it was then, a supreme work of mercy because it involves giving the living water of the Spirit. As many an addict will tell you, it is a thirst that men have destroyed their lives seeking to quench with earthly satisfactions that promise life or at least relief, but instead delivers death and despair.

If food is the Word of God then water is the Holy Spirit by which we bathe our souls in the Essence of God and are made ready for our missions and purpose in life. While we must hear and spread that Word, our efforts will be empty unless they are in that Holy Spirit that guides us and fills us with the refreshing energy and passion so vital to living and sharing that Word and that example.

To give drink to the thirsty also carries the duty to make clean water available to everyone. Today there are many parts of the world, where fresh drinking water is scarce or impossible to find, where untreated water coming from streams and ponds is full of water-borne diseases. The illness from drinking dirty water and the time lost fetching it, robs entire communities of their futures. And in many places, synthetic hormones are making their way into the water supply where they can interfere with the physiology of humans and animals alike.
