THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, February 8 St. Josephine Bakhita. Born in southern Sudan, Josephine was kidnapped at the age of seven, sold into slavery and given the name Bakhita, which means fortunate. She was re-sold several times, finally in 1883 to Callisto Legnani, Italian consul in Khartoum, Sudan. He took her to Italy and gave her to the Michielis family to babysit their daughter, through whom Bakhita became acquainted with the Canossian Sisters. She was baptized and confirmed in 1890, taking the name Josephine. When the Michielis were to return to Africa they wanted to take Josephine with them, but she refused to go. During the ensuing court case, the Canossian sisters and the patriarch of Venice intervened on Josephine's behalf. The judge concluded that since slavery was illegal in Italy, she had actually been free since 1885.

Josephine entered the Institute of St. Magdalene of Canossa in 1893 and made her profession three years later. She once said, "Be good, love the Lord, pray for those who do not know Him. What a great grace it is to know God!"

Thursday, February 11 <u>Our Lady of Lourdes</u>. Three years after Pope Pius IX proclaimed the dogma of the Immaculate Conception, a series of visions were given to a poor young girl named Bernadette Soubirous, of a beautiful young woman who identified herself as "the Immaculate Conception". The first vision was on February 11, 1858.

In one vision she was directed to drink from a spot where an underground stream suddenly gushed forth. Almost immediately cures were reported from drinking the water. Our Lady asked that a chapel be built on the spot and processions to be made to the grotto. Today the Basilica of the Rosary sits next to the chapel.

The Corporal Work of Mercy - Burying the Dead

The Corporal Works are practical deeds aimed at relieving bodily distress. The first six are listed in the Biblical parable of the Sheep and the Goats and are the criteria by which Christ will judge his people. As early as the third century "burying the Dead", was added because it is highly praised in the Book of Tobit; and to bring the number up to seven, a number that signifies completion and perfection.

No doubt most of us make sure that our relatives and friends have a proper funeral service. But we also need to be aware of the needs of those who are grieving and must "bury their dead" emotionally. We need to help one another to truly bury our lost loved ones by letting go of them, entrusting them to the hands of our merciful Creator and Savior. That takes friendship — a patient friendship that keeps on visiting the bereaved, keeps on helping them dry their tears, even when the grieving process takes many months or even years. This is a precious work of mercy: to help one another emotionally "bury the dead," entrusting them finally to the merciful Heart of the Redeemer.

In this regard there is something very powerful about the Catholic Tradition of offering Masses for the eternal repose of souls. This tradition of offering Masses for others, particularly the dead, originates in the very early Church. St. Ambrose preached, "We have loved them during life; let us not abandon them in death, until we have conducted them by our prayers into the house of the Lord." St. John Chrysostom stated, "Let us help and commemorate them. If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice, why would we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation? Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them."

LENTEN FASTING & ABSTINENCE

In preparation for the Solemn Feast of Easter, the faithful do penance through fasting, almsgiving, prayers, works of mercy and abstinence from meat. All Fridays are days of abstinence from meat, but in Canada, Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. The law of abstinence binds those who are 14 years of age and up. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are mandatory days of fasting. On fast days Church discipline permits one to take a main and two lesser meatless meals which do not equal the main meal. The law of fasting binds those from 18 – 59 years of age.
