#### THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

**Monday Feb. 11: St. Scholastica** (480 - 542) is the Patron Saint of Nuns & Religious women. She was the twin sister of St. Benedict, the Patriarch of Western monasticism. Scholastica was dedicated to God from a young age and some said she preceded Benedict in godliness. Inspired by Benedict's teaching, she devoted her life to seeking and serving God. She also is the founder of the women's branch of Benedictine Monasticism.

**Friday, Feb. 14: St. Cyril and St. Methodius** (9th century), the apostles to the Slavs, were brothers who through great effort and in spite of tremendous difficulties converted the Slavonic nations. They translated the Bible into Slavonic and devised glagolitic writing, used to the present day in the liturgical services of some Eastern rites. In 867, they came to Rome and met Pope Hadrian where Cyril died at the young age of 42. Methodius returned to Moravia. labored as a missionary among the Hungarians, Bulgarians, Dalmatians, and the inhabitants of Carinthia.

#### WORLD DAY OF THE SICK: FEBRUARY 11



The 23rd World Day of the Sick will be celebrated, as it is every year, on February 11,

2015, the memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes. This year, the Holy Father's Message is entitled: "I was eyes to the blind, and feet to the lame" (Job 29.15). In his Message, Pope Francis invites the ill, the professionals and volunteers in the field of the health care, and all of us to reflect on the wisdom of the heart (*sapientia cordis*) "This 'wisdom' is not theoretical, abstract knowledge, the product of reasoning. Rather, it is, as Saint James describes it in his Letter, 'pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, without uncertainty or insincerity' (3.17)".

"...I entrust this World Day of the Sick to the maternal protection of Mary, who conceived and gave birth to Wisdom incarnate: Jesus Christ, our Lord.

O Mary, Seat of Wisdom, intercede as our Mother for all the sick and for those who care for them! Grant that, through our service of our suffering neighbours, and through the experience of suffering itself, we may receive and cultivate true wisdom of heart!

#### CARDINAL COLLINS IS URGING CATHOLICS TO SUPPORT PHYSICIANS' CHARTER OF RIGHT OF FREEDOM OF CONSCIENCE & RELIGION

The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO), in a proposed new draft document states: "Where physicians are unwilling to provide certain elements of care due to their moral or religious beliefs, an effective referral to another health care provider must be provided to the patient". **Catholic physicians believe that a mandate for an "effective referral" is a violation of a physician's rights, as it** *compels the physician to violate his or her own conscience by being a participant in the very act, the very procedure to which he or she objects in the first place.* 

The CPSO is accepting submissions from all Ontario citizens until <u>February 20</u>. We are all called to inform the CPSO in writing that we reject the proposed "effective referral" mandate for doctors whose Charter right of freedom of conscience and religion must be respected.
