### THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday January 2,St. Basil the Great. A man of vast learning and constant activity, genuine eloquence and immense charity he first was a lawyer but later became a monk and found a monastery for which he wrote a famous monastic rule. He was given the title of "Great" during his life and Doctor of the Church after his death. Basil was one of the giants of the early Church.

St Gregory of Nazianzen skillfully avoided a schism that threatened when his own father made compromises with Arianism. When protection for Arianism ended with the death of Valens, Gregory was called to rebuild the faith in the great see of Constantinople, which had been under Arian teachers for three decades. He is famous for his great sermons on the Trinity. In time, Gregory did rebuild the faith in the city, but at the cost of great suffering, slander, insults and even personal violence.

Saturay January 7th, St. Andre Bessette, Born in Quebec; sickness and weakness dogged André from birth. After a year's novitiate, he was not admitted entrance into the Congregation of the Holy Cross because of his weak health. But with an extension and the urging of Bishop Bourget he was finally received. He was given the humble job of doorkeeper at Notre Dame College in Montreal, with additional duties as sacristan, laundry worker and messenger. He performed humble tasks for over forty years and entrusted all of the poor and sick who flocked to his cell to the care of St. Joseph. During his life he was able to have a chapel built to the spouse of the Virgin Mary. After his death, the shrine grew into the great basilica known as St. Joseph's Oratory in Montreal.

Saturday January 7<sup>t</sup>, St. Raymond of Penafort; the patron saint of Canonists was a Dominican priest who worked to aid Christian captives during the era of the Crusades and also helped organize the Church's legal code, He is. A contemporary of Saint Thomas Aquinas, he inspired the theologian to write the "Summa Contra Gentiles" for the conversion of non-Catholics. At least 10,000 Muslims reportedly converted as a result of St. Raymond's evangelistic labors.

### MARY, THE HOLY MOTHER OF GOD

If Jesus is Life, Mary is the Mother of Life. If Jesus is Hope, Mary is the Mother of Hope. If Jesus is Peace, Mary is the Mother of Peace, Mother of the Prince of Peace.

"Hail, holy Mother! The Child to whom you gave birth is the King of heaven and earth for ever". With this ancient greeting, today, the 8<sup>th</sup> day of the Octave of Christmas and the first of the year the Church greets the Blessed Virgin Mary, invoking her as Mother of God. In her the eternal Son of the Father took our very flesh and through Her became "son of David and son of Abraham" (Mt 1,1). Thus Mary is his true Mother: the Theotokos, Mother of God! Entering the new year, let us ask this holy Mother to bless us. Let us ask Her to give us Jesus, our full Blessing, in whom the Father blessed all history once and for all, making it become the history of salvation.

Justice and forgiveness: these are the two "pillars" of peace. Between justice and forgiveness there is not opposition but complementarity, because both are essential for promoting peace. Indeed, far more than a temporary ceasefire, this is the deep healing of the wounds that weary souls. Only forgiveness can quench the thirst for revenge and open hearts to an authentic and lasting reconciliation among peoples. This appeal for justice and peace is first and foremost for those who believe in God, in particular for the great "Abrahamic religions": Judaism, Christianity and Islam, called to declare their firm and decisive rejection of violence. No one, for any reason, can kill in the name of God, who is one and merciful. God is life and the source of life. To believe in Him means to witness to His mercy and forgiveness, rejecting the exploitation of his holy Name.

An agonizing cry for peace is being raised from various parts of the world; it is rising particularly from the Land which God blessed with his Covenant and his Incarnation and for this reason is called "Holy". "The voice of your brother's blood" cries out to God from that land (cf. Gn 4,10); the blood of brothers poured out by brothers who hark back to the same Patriarch Abraham; sons, like every human being, of the same heavenly Father.

Today we turn our gaze to the Child whom Mary holds in her arms. In Him we recognize the One in whom mercy and truth meet, justice and peace embrace (*Ps 84,11*). In Him we adore the true Messiah, in whom, for our salvation, God joined together truth and mercy, justice and forgiveness. The Child born in Bethlehem is the eternal Word of the Father who became flesh for our salvation, he is "God-with-us", who brings with him the secret of true peace. He is the Prince of Peace.




